There is no official parking for the trail but you can park along city streets. If you're linking to the Intervale Trail, you can park at Intervale Center (180 Intervale Road).



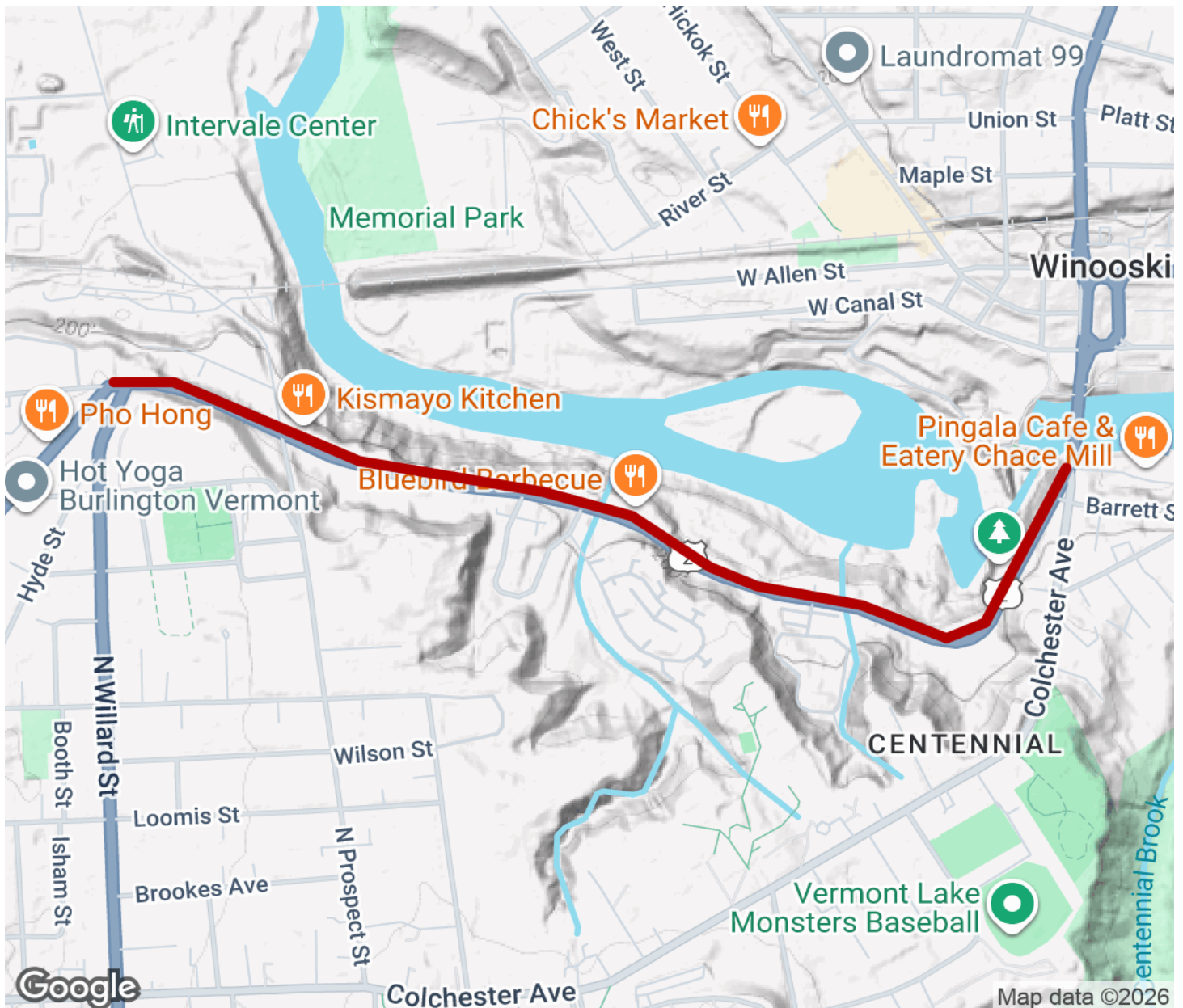
