The path links suburbs and parks, and passes by the Ethan Allen Homestead, which features a museum and year-round events (fees apply). 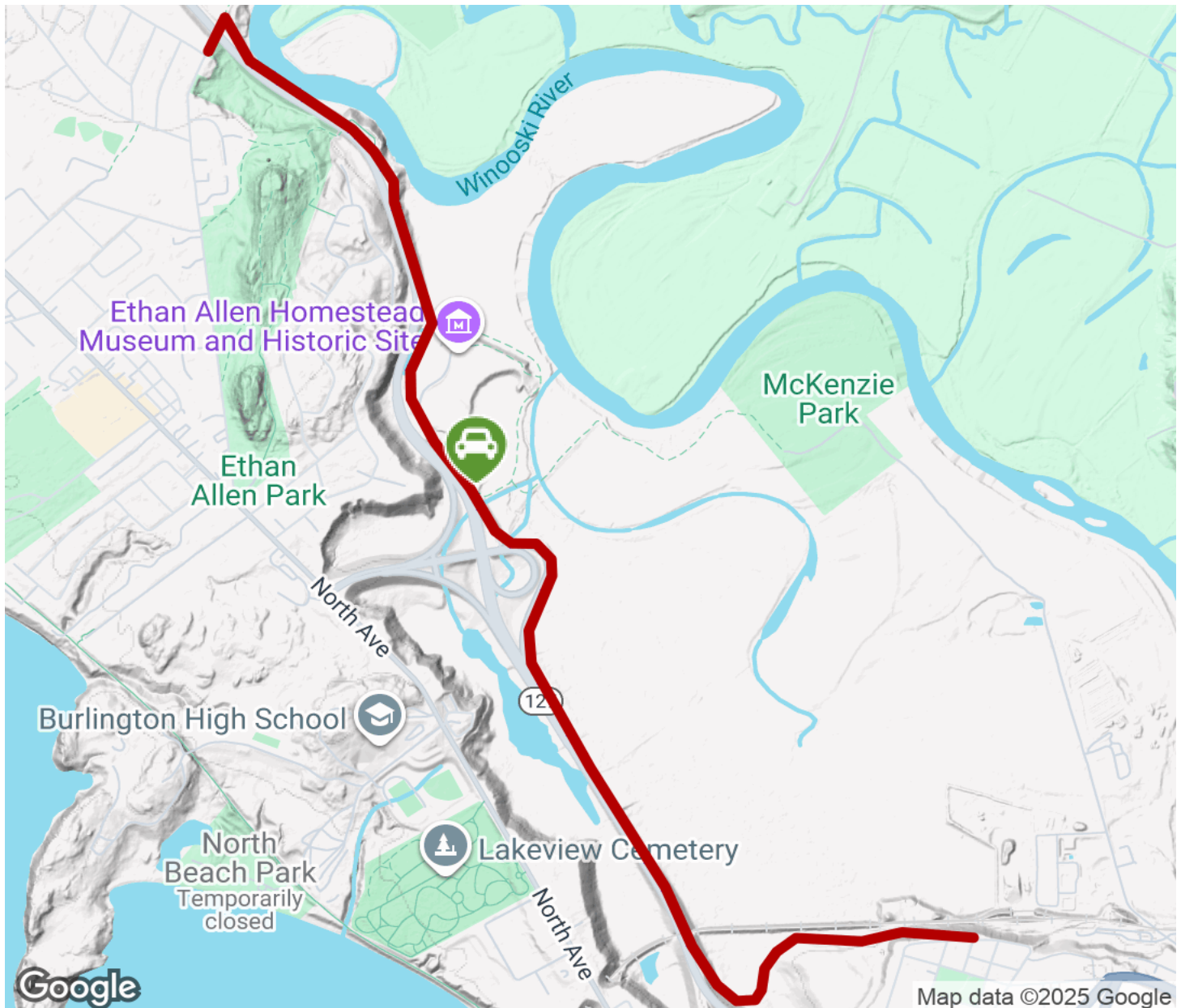
