Newblock Park Trail runs for 1.5 miles between US 412/64/Sand Springs Expressway at N. 25th W. and Southwest Boulevard (11th



Newblock Park Trail runs for 1.5 miles between US 412/64/ Sand Springs Expressway at N. 25th W. and Southwest Boulevard (11th Street bridge). The trail links the Riverparks trail system (<u>West Bank</u> and <u>East Bank</u>) and the <u>KATY Trail</u>.

Along the trail you'll find a memorial to Tulsa Police (at Charles Page Blvd.). Use caution crossing at Charles Page Boulevard near Newblock Park since there is no pedestrian signal.
