The trail serves as a sturdy path through the Murfreesboro Greenway system. Trail users can tread the asphalt while experiencing all the greenery and wildlife the area has to offer. 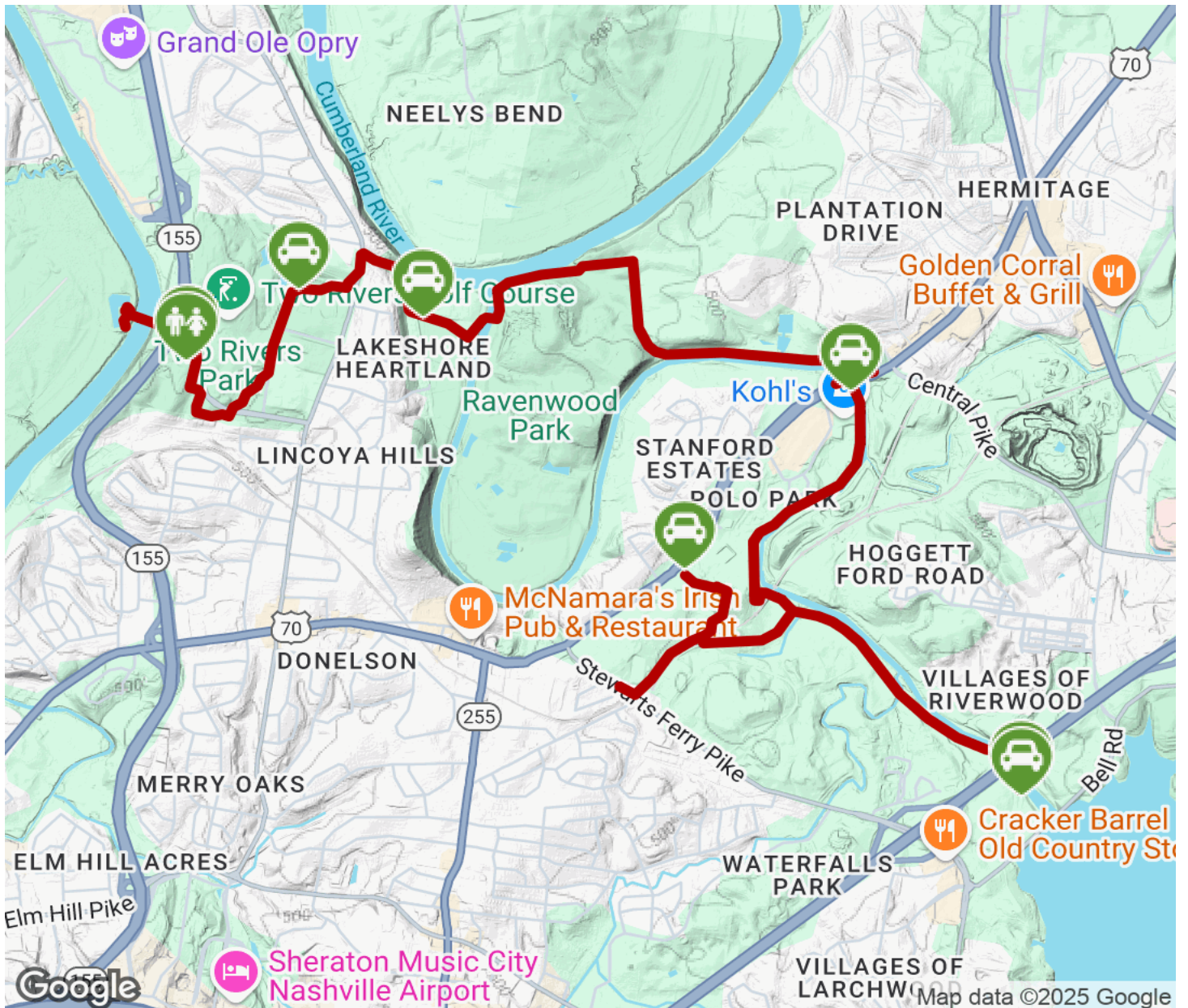
