The Linton Hall Road Trail runs parallel to its namesake—also signed as State Route 619—in western Prince William County. More utilitarian than scenic, the trail acts as a transportation route for local residents of the communities lining the road from Gainesville to Bristow.

Near the trail's midpoint, connect to the [Sudley Manor Drive Trail](#) to travel north to Bull Run.


