About the Route

Both lakes are the largest remaining glacial wetlands in Cuyahoga County and both are critical habitats for local wildlife. While most of the trail runs through woodlands and wetlands, a short section on Hepburn Road between Bagley Road and Jefferson Parkway (near the movie theater) uses the adjacent sidewalk.

Parking & Trail Access


