The winding 3rd Street Trail parallels an irrigation ditch between Interstate 135 and Lorraine Avenue in Wichita, making a link



The winding 3rd Street Trail parallels an irrigation ditch between Interstate 135 and Lorraine Avenue in Wichita, making a link between disconnected portions of 3rd Street via a non-motorized route. The trail was constructed along with Third and Piatt Park in 1999, which converted the street to a landscaped corridor. 3 benches, a picnic table and playground line the trail.

Just under I-135, the trail links with the north-south running [Canal Hike and Bike Trail](#).

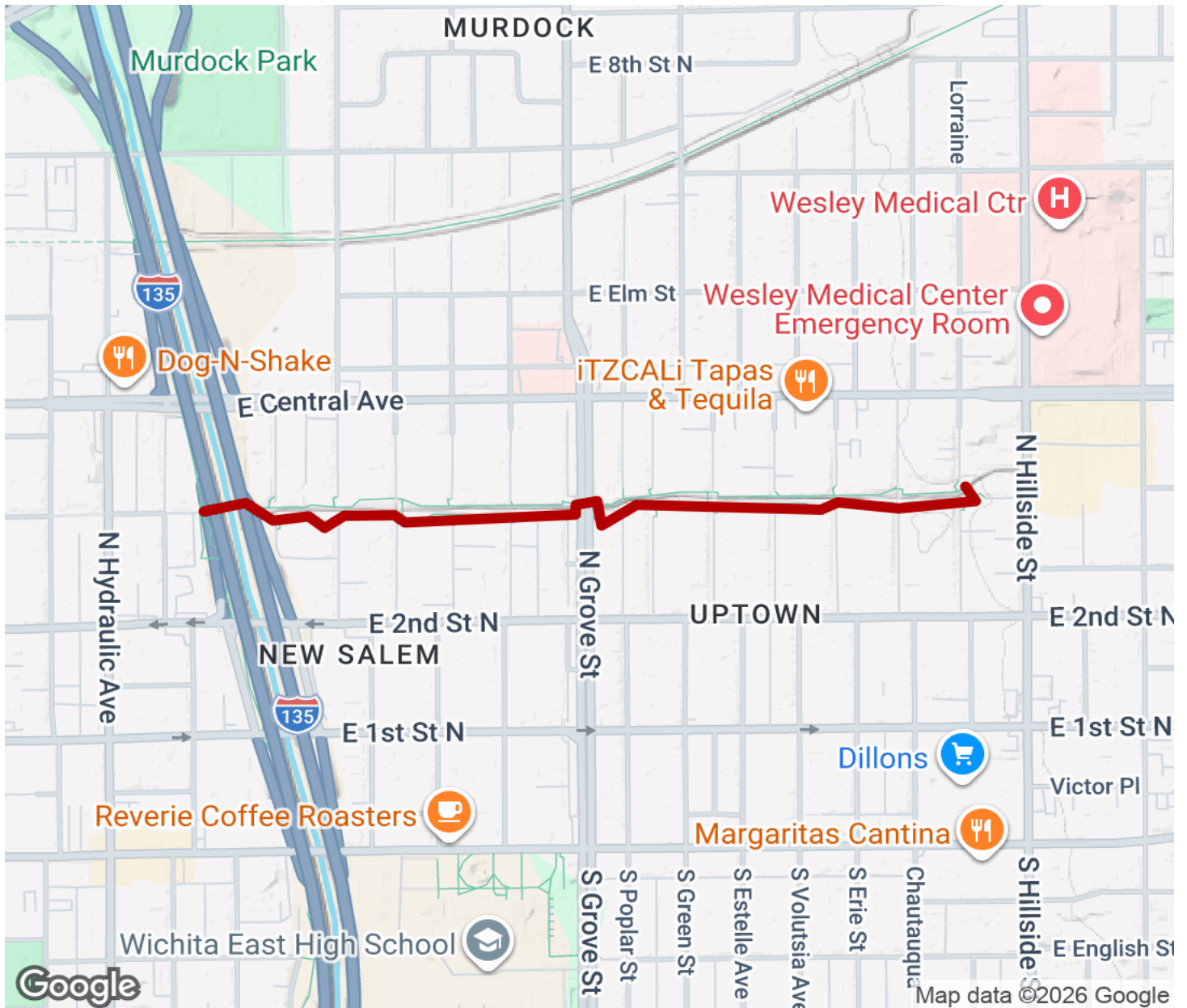
Parking & Trail Access
