The Riverfront Trail in The Dalles, Oregon is a scenic paved pathway along the Columbia River from the Columbia Gorge Discovery Center parking lot east to The Dalles Dam. The trail offers a number of interesting sites including the Riverfront Park, the marina, a campsite that Lewis & Clark slept in, the delightful Learning Garden with a scarecrow collection, the wild Chenoweth Creek and the lakes and ridges of the wildlife refuge below the Discovery Center. The trail may be windy, but never boring.
