Trail end points: Hunter Trail (not a trail but a road- Southern Pines) to Reservoir Park Trail

Trail surfaces: Gravel, Sand

Trail category: Greenway/Non-RT

Trail activities: Bike, Walking

Parking & Trail Access

You can park along Hunter Trail Road. From the Pinehurst traffic circle, take the exit toward Southern Pines for SR 2 East; turn left at Knoll Road. Continue to Hunter Trail Road and park near the pond.

You can also access this trail from Reservoir Park, where parking is available.




