**Trail activities:** Bike, Walking

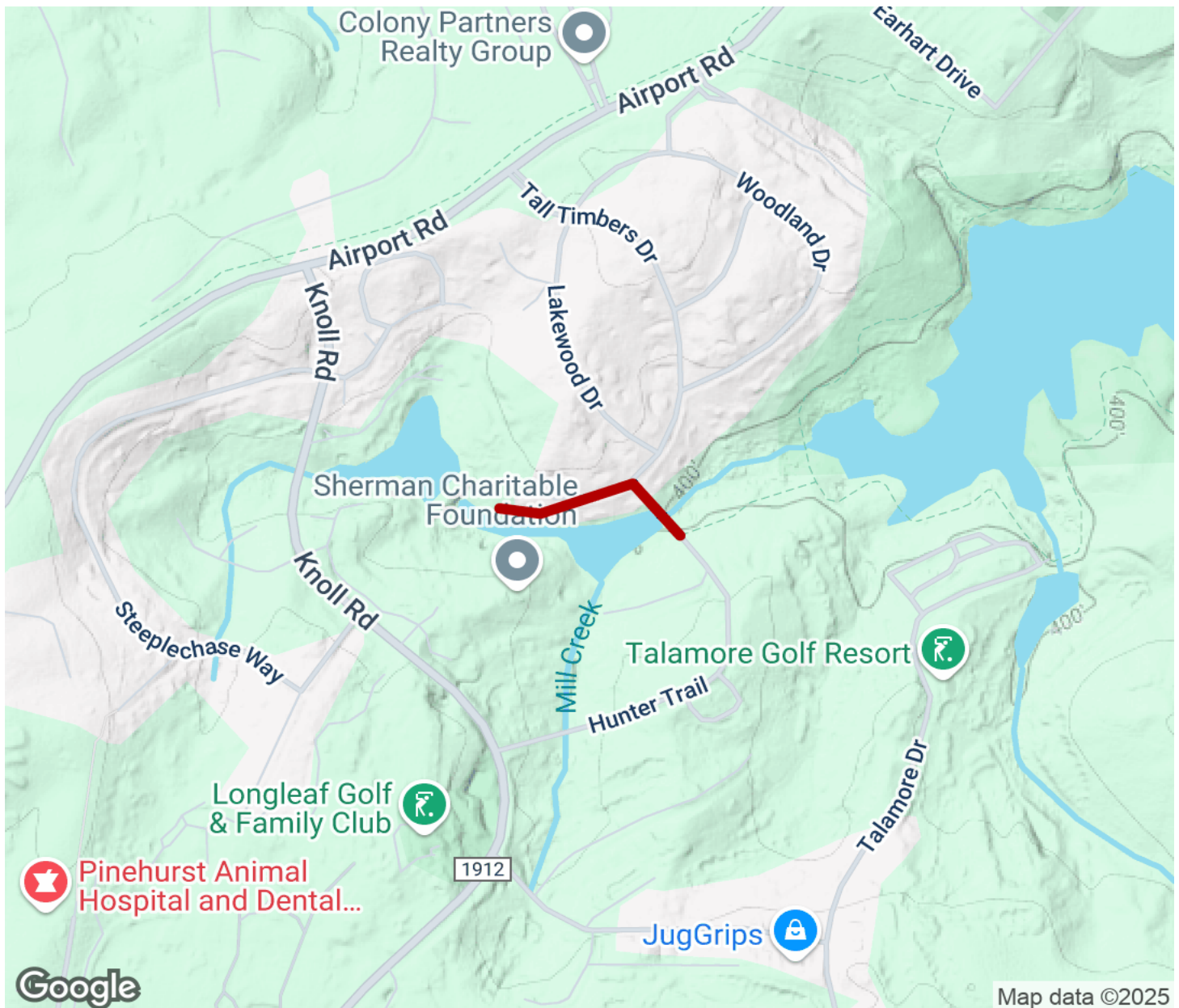
## Parking & Trail Access
