The trail loops around the Southern Pines Reservoir (95 acres) through wooded areas, over a dam and past residential areas.

Reservoir Park includes hiking, biking, boating, fishing and picnicking; it is also wheelchair accessible.

The Reservoir Park Greenway connects to the <u>Forest</u> <u>Creek Access Trail</u> and the <u>Tall Timbers Trail</u>. It also connects to the <u>Mill Creek Trail</u>.

Parking & Trail Access


You can park at Reservoir Park, 300 Reservoir Park Road, off Central Drive, Hwy 22. For information: 910-692-2463.

You can also park along Hunter Trail Road and take that trail to the Reservoir Park loop. From the Pinehurst traffic circle, take the exit toward Southern Pines for SR 2 East; turn left at Knoll Road. Continue to Hunter Trail Road and park near the pond.
