## Wadsworth Trail

South Carolina

*The Wadsworth Trail parallels Willis Road from Harmon Drive to Hawk Creek Drive, with a spur heading south along SR 42-4382/*



The Wadsworth Trail parallels Willis Road from Harmon Drive to Hawk Creek Drive, with a spur heading south along SR 42-4382/Caldwell Drive. The Willis Road portion is 1.85 miles (one way), while the Caldwell Drive portion to just north of Dartmoor Drive is just under 1 mile (one way). The paved Wadsworth Trail is a mix of flat sections and long, rolling hills.

## Parking & Trail Access

From downtown Spartanburg, take US 29 south for about 4 miles (passing under I-26 at 3.5 miles). Turn left at S Blackstock Road; turn right (at the first light) onto Willis Road. The trail begins about 0.5 mile ahead on the left.



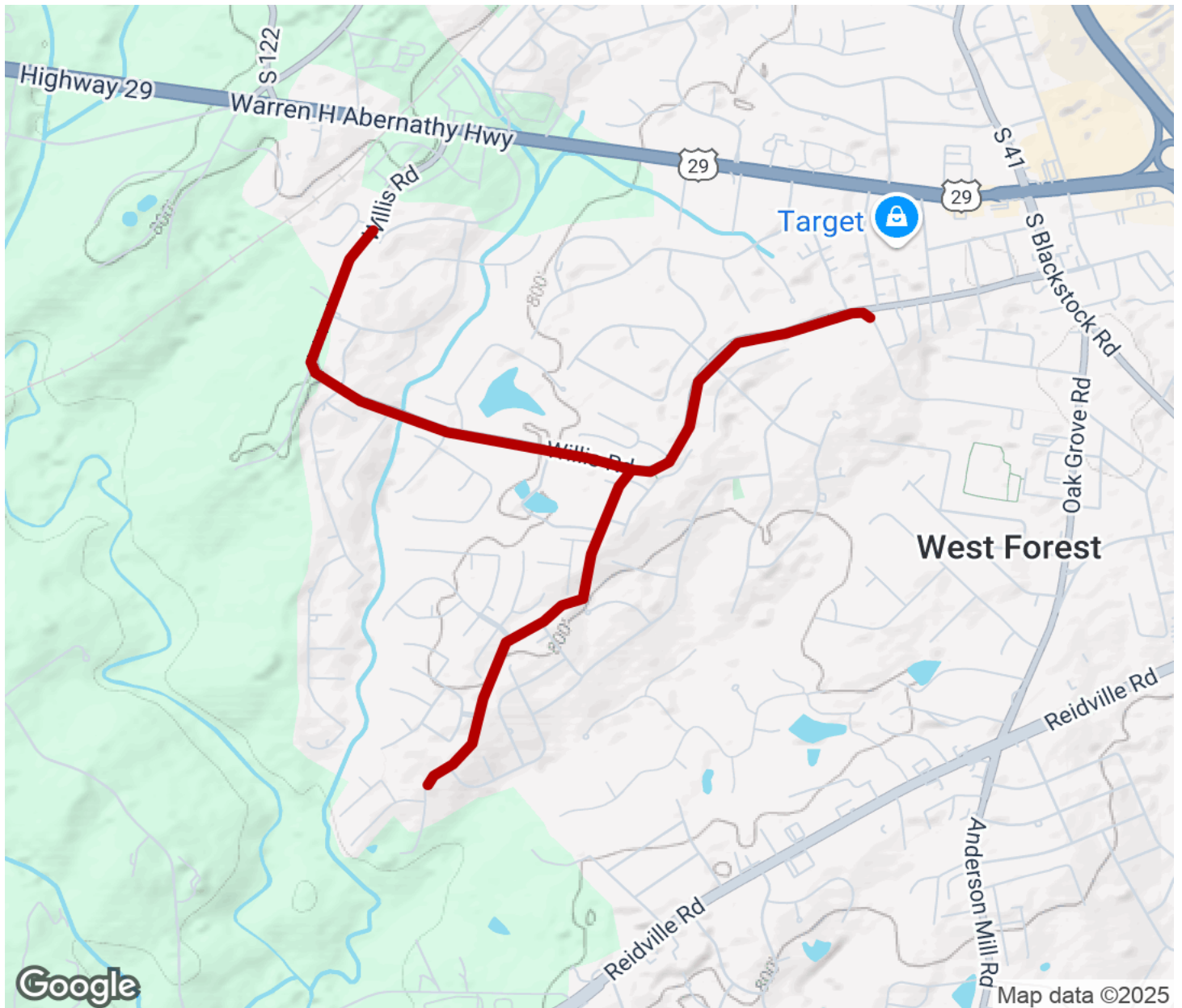
