The Wadsworth Trail parallels Willis Road from Harmon Drive to Hawk Creek Drive, with a spur heading south along SR 42-4382/



The Wadsworth Trail parallels Willis Road from Harmon Drive to Hawk Creek Drive, with a spur heading south along SR 42-4382/Caldwell Drive. The Willis Road portion is 1.85 miles, while the Caldwell Drive portion to just north of Dartmoor Drive is just under one mile. The paved Wadsworth Trail is a mix of flat sections and long, rolling hills.

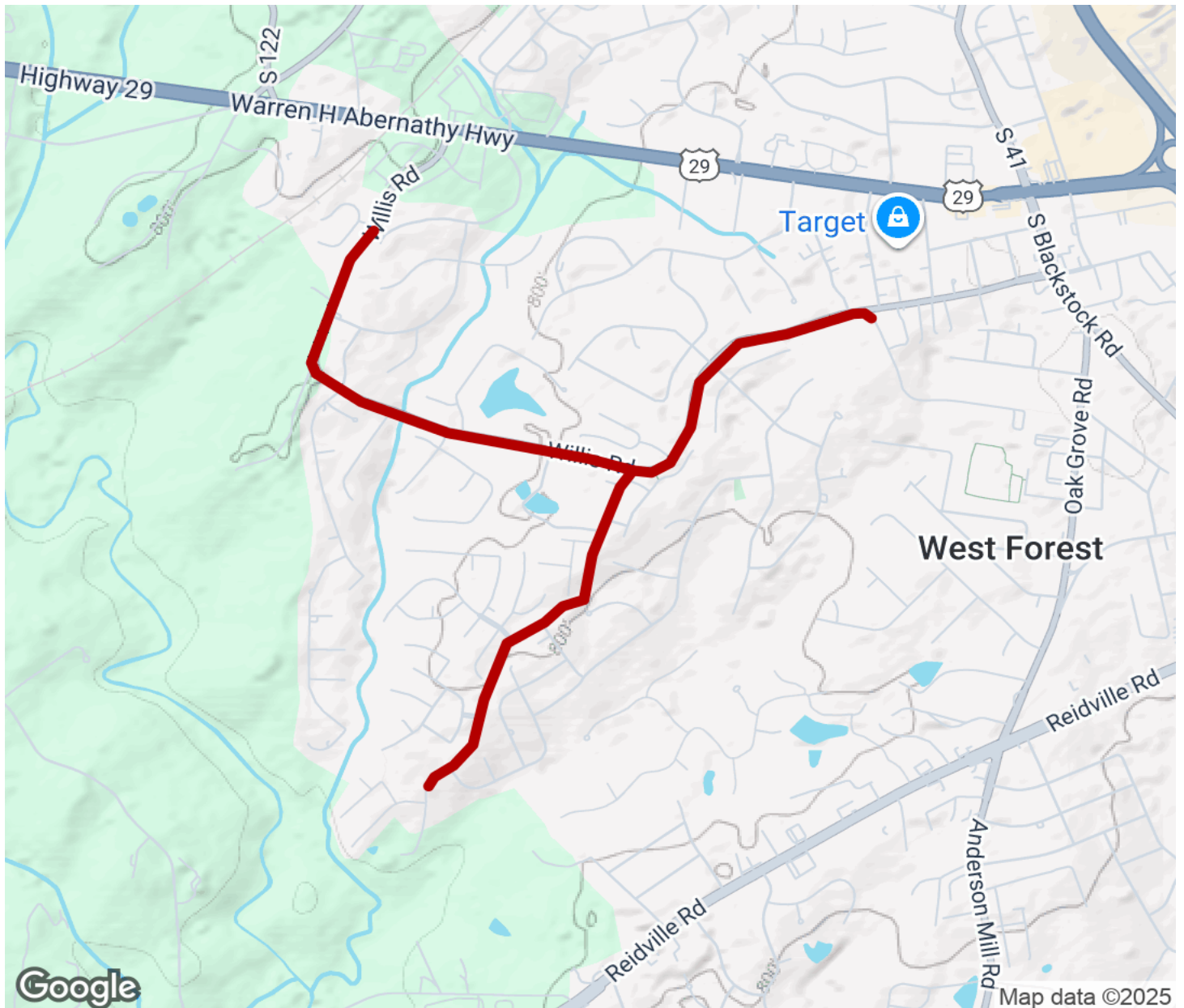
