Parking is available at numerous points along the trail, including:

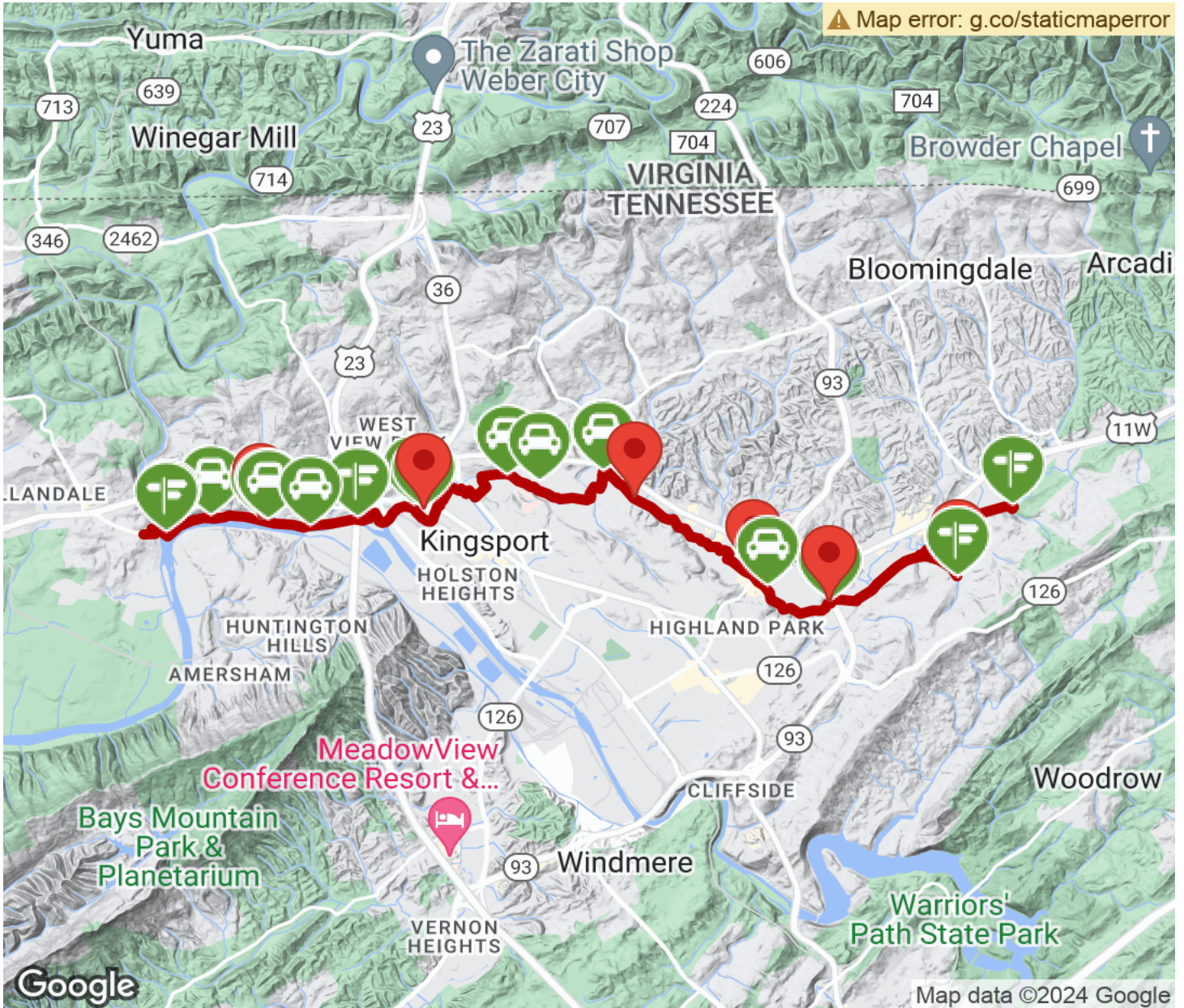
- Netherland Inn Rd (Kingsport)
