## The Indian Bend Wash Path—also sometimes referred to as the Indian Bend Wash Greenbelt or the Scottsdale Greenbelt—



The Indian Bend Wash Path—also sometimes referred to as the Indian Bend Wash Greenbelt or the Scottsdale Greenbelt—follows the banks of Indian Bend Wash between Scottsdale and Tempe. Along the way, the paved 12-mile path connects a number of public parks, schools and businesses.

#### About the Route

There are two discrete sections. The northern segment runs almost 4.5 miles from Venturoso Park through Phoenix Indian Bend Wash Park down to E Shea Blvd in Scottsdale.

The southern segment is longer, spanning more than 7.5 miles. A highlight of the route is Scottsdale's Eldorado

Park, which is located about mid-trail. The 60-acre park offers a swimming pool, fishing lake, athletic facilities, skate park, playgrounds and picnic areas. Farther north, the lake in Chaparral Park offers a popular place to fish and walk around.

#### Connections

The path is also an important link in the local trail network as it connects to the <u>Rio Salado Pathway</u> at its southern end (which follows both of Tempe Town Lake's shores) and both the <u>Arizona Canal Path</u> (which heads west to Phoenix) and <u>Central Arizona Project to Arizona Canal Trail</u> at its northern end.

The Indian Bend Wash Path is in two sections: it runs between Venturoso Park (Phoenix) and E Shea Blvd (Scottsdale), and between the Scottsdale Nature Area (Scottsdale) and E Curry Rd (Tempe).
