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The Kyrene Canal Path runs alongside the Kyrene Canal in Tempe and Chandler, providing a connection between residences, businesses, shopping destinations and the Ken McDonald Golf Course. The trail is paved and landscaped throughout Tempe, but the surface transitions to gravel and then crushed stone as it becomes more of a neighborhood dog-walking and jogging route at its southern end in Chandler.

At its northern end (near where the Kyrene Canal feeds into the Western Canal), the trail also connects to the longer [Western Canal Path](#). Take that trail east to reach Mesa, Chandler and Gilbert.

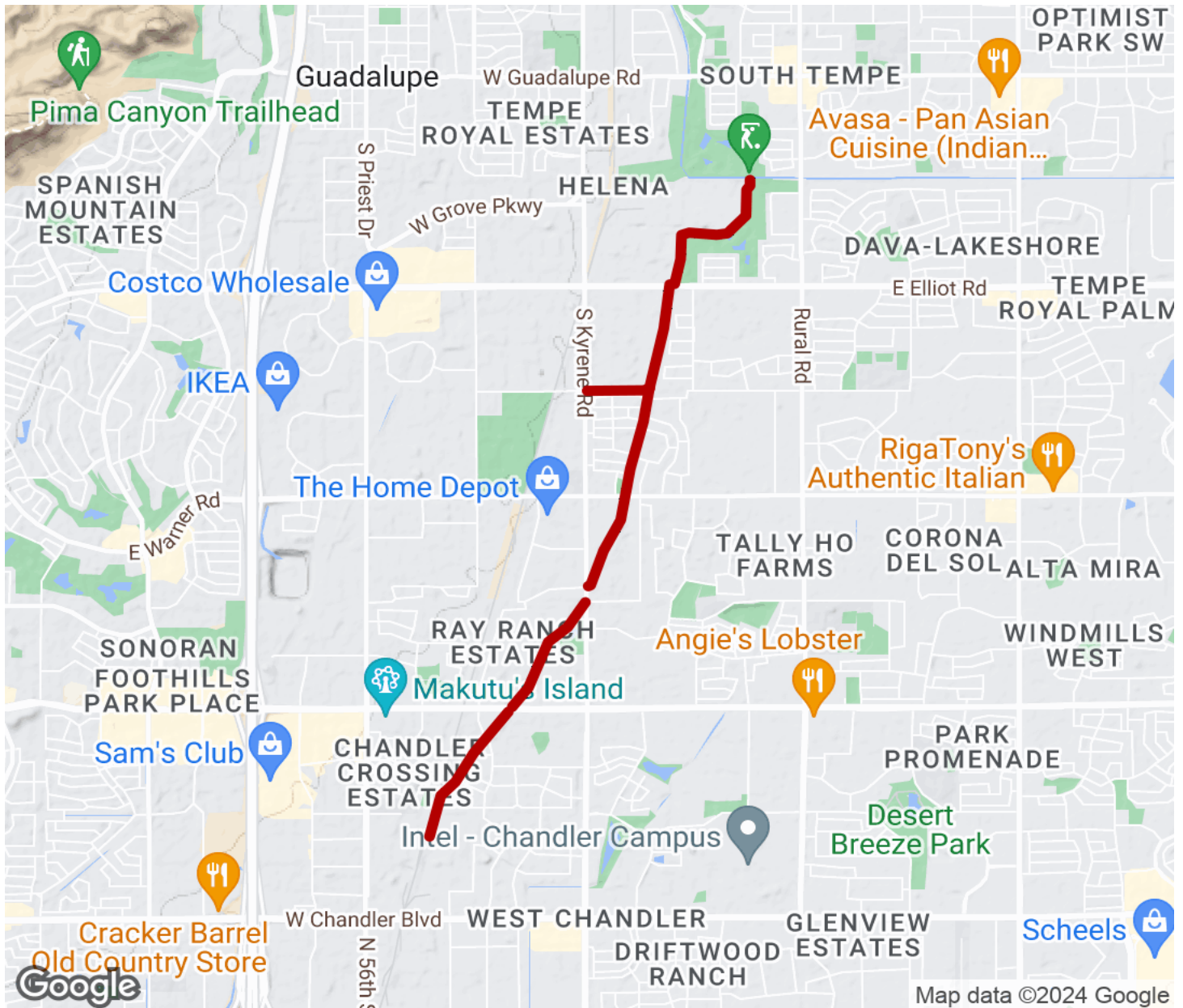
Parking & Trail Access
