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The Pima Road Trail consists of two disconnected segments along Pima Road in Scottsdale. The longer southern section connects to both the [Arizona Canal Path](#) and [Central Arizona Project to Arizona Canal Trail](#), offering opportunities for additional journeys throughout the region.

Both sections of the trail have a suburban feel to them, providing access to residential areas and businesses.


Parking & Trail Access
