The Queen Creek Wash Trail has a more rural feel than other trails in the Phoenix metropolitan area. Located within the community of



The Queen Creek Wash Trail has a more rural feel than other trails in the Phoenix metropolitan area. Located within the community of Queen Creek, and following the banks of Queen Creek Wash, this trail passes open space, farmland and some smaller residential communities.

At the trail's southeastern end, Desert Mountain Park features several athletic fields, playgrounds and picnic shelters. The trail continues from there for a little over 1 mile and ends near a residential development, along East Village Loop Road.

Two blocks west of the trail, travelers can also connect to the [Sonoqui Wash Trail](#), a paved pathway spanning nearly 6 miles.

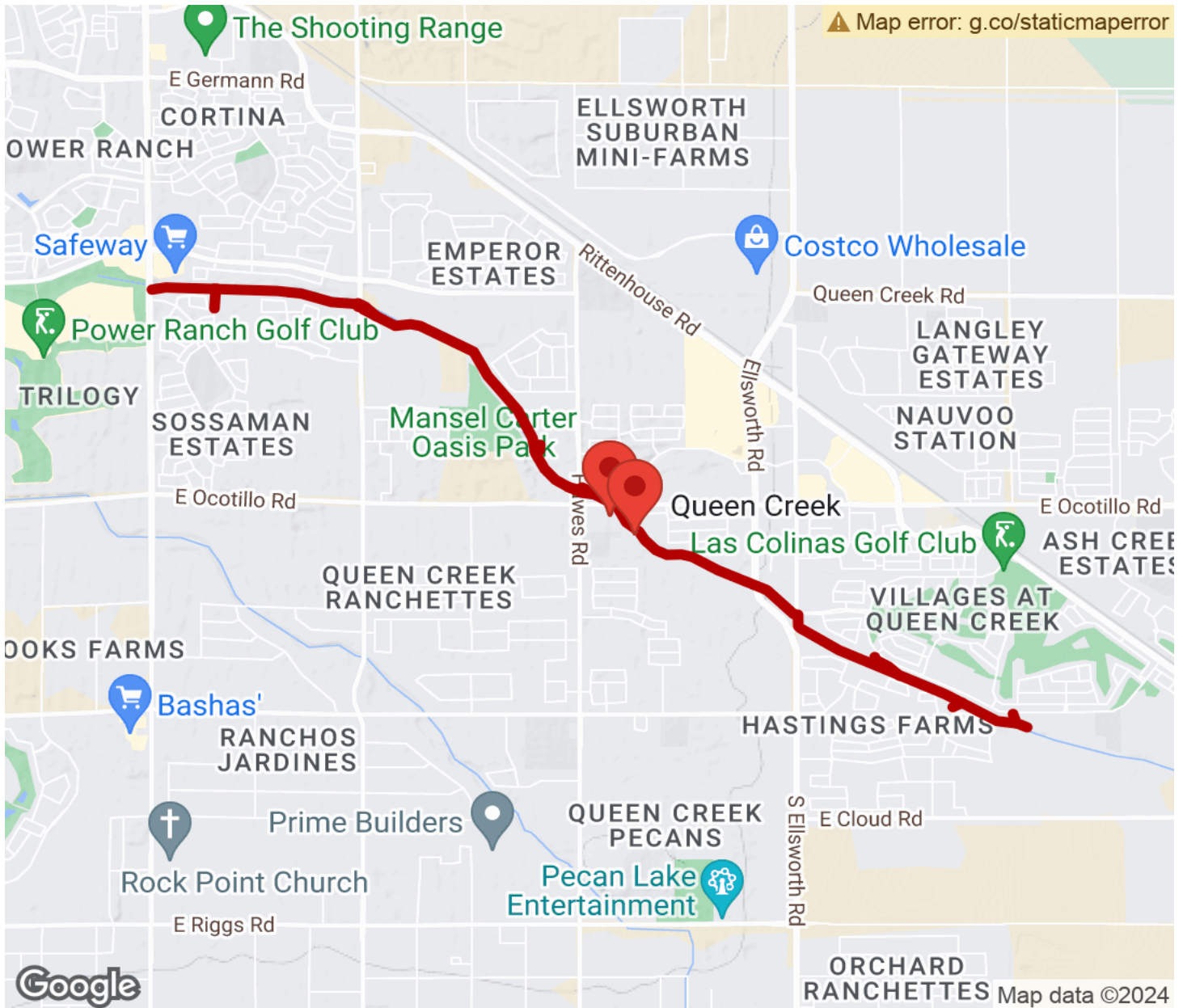
