The rural-feeling Queen Creek Wash Trail runs for 7 miles between the communities of Queen Creek and Hastings Farm. This paved



throughout the duration of the route. The eastern endpoint and trailhead for the Queen Creek Wash Trail is just off S. Rittenhouse Rd.

The rural-feeling Queen Creek Wash Trail runs for 7 miles between the communities of Queen Creek and Hastings Farm. This paved trail passes through open space, farmland, residential communities, and playgrounds.

About the Route

The western endpoint of the Queen Creek Wash Trail is located at Power Rd between Jacaranda Blvd and E Queen Creek Rd in Queen Creek. Heading east, the tree-lined trail passes by residential neighborhoods as it follows Queen Creek. Near the middle of the route, the trail passes through Desert Mountain Park before continuing to the trail's eastern endpoint in Hastings Farm. The trail offers numerous outlets into passing neighborhoods

Parking & Trail Access


