You can access the trail along Falls Creek Drive and Place and along Tuscany Circle. There is no official parking area.



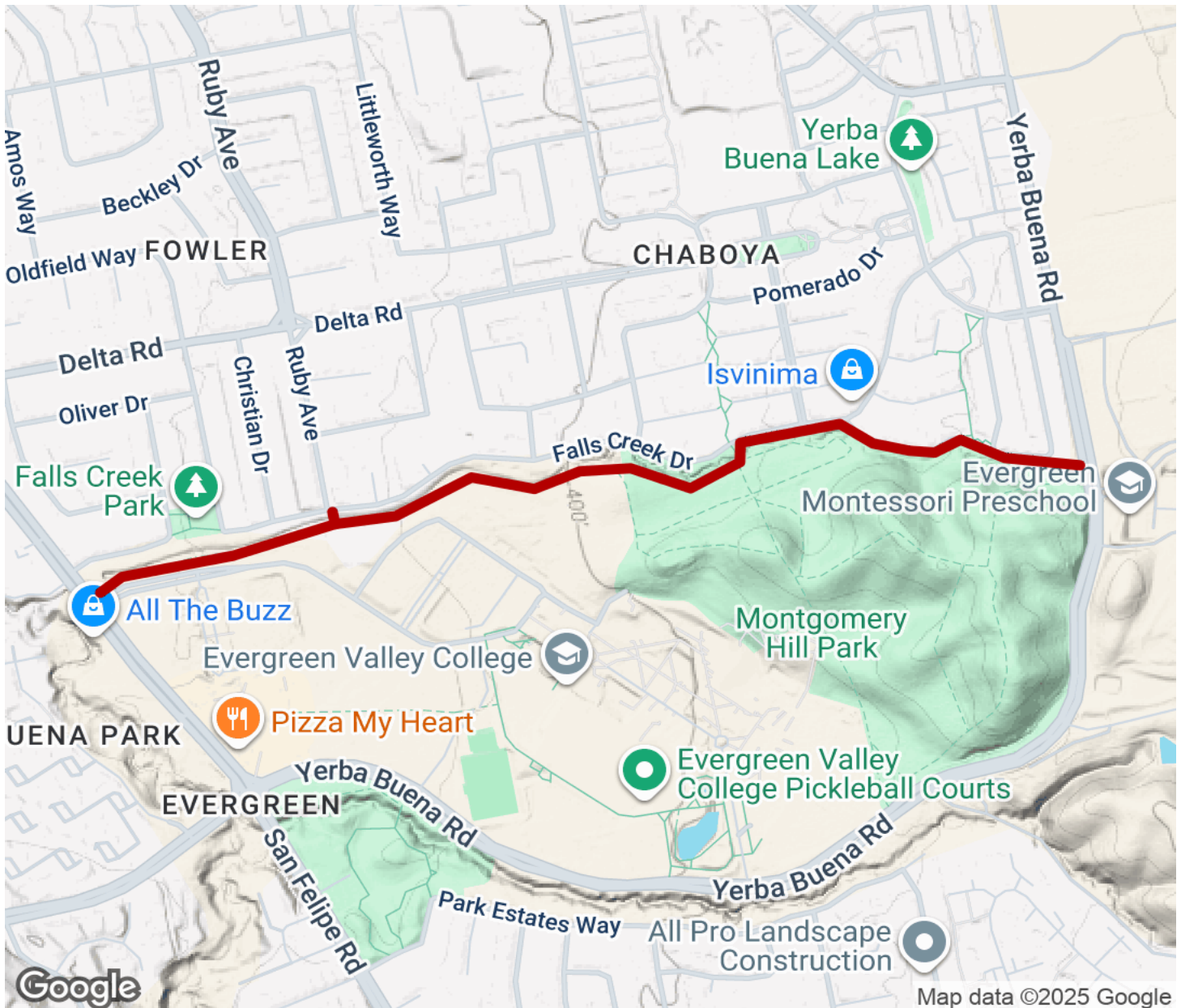
