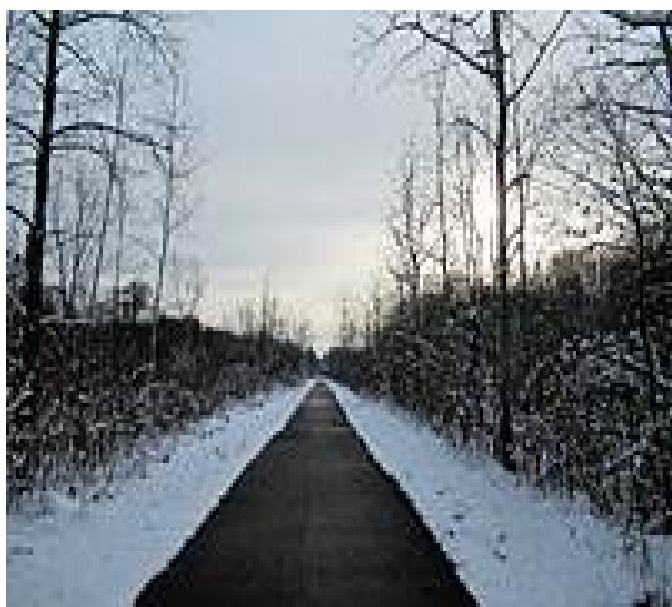

Trout Island Trail

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The Trout Island Trail is a 2.4 mile rail-trail along the former Erie and Pittsburgh Railroad and runs from the borough of Sharpsville to South Pymatuning Township following the Shenango River as well as Shenango Dam and Lake.

The trail offers a pleasant mix of views, including woodlands, farmlands, and the Shenango Dam. Eagles frequent the river banks. The first half mile of the trail, from Sharpsville to the dam, is downhill; from there, the trail levels out and provides a smooth, easy ride. When trees are bare in the winter and spring, chances are pretty good you will spot an eagle or two.

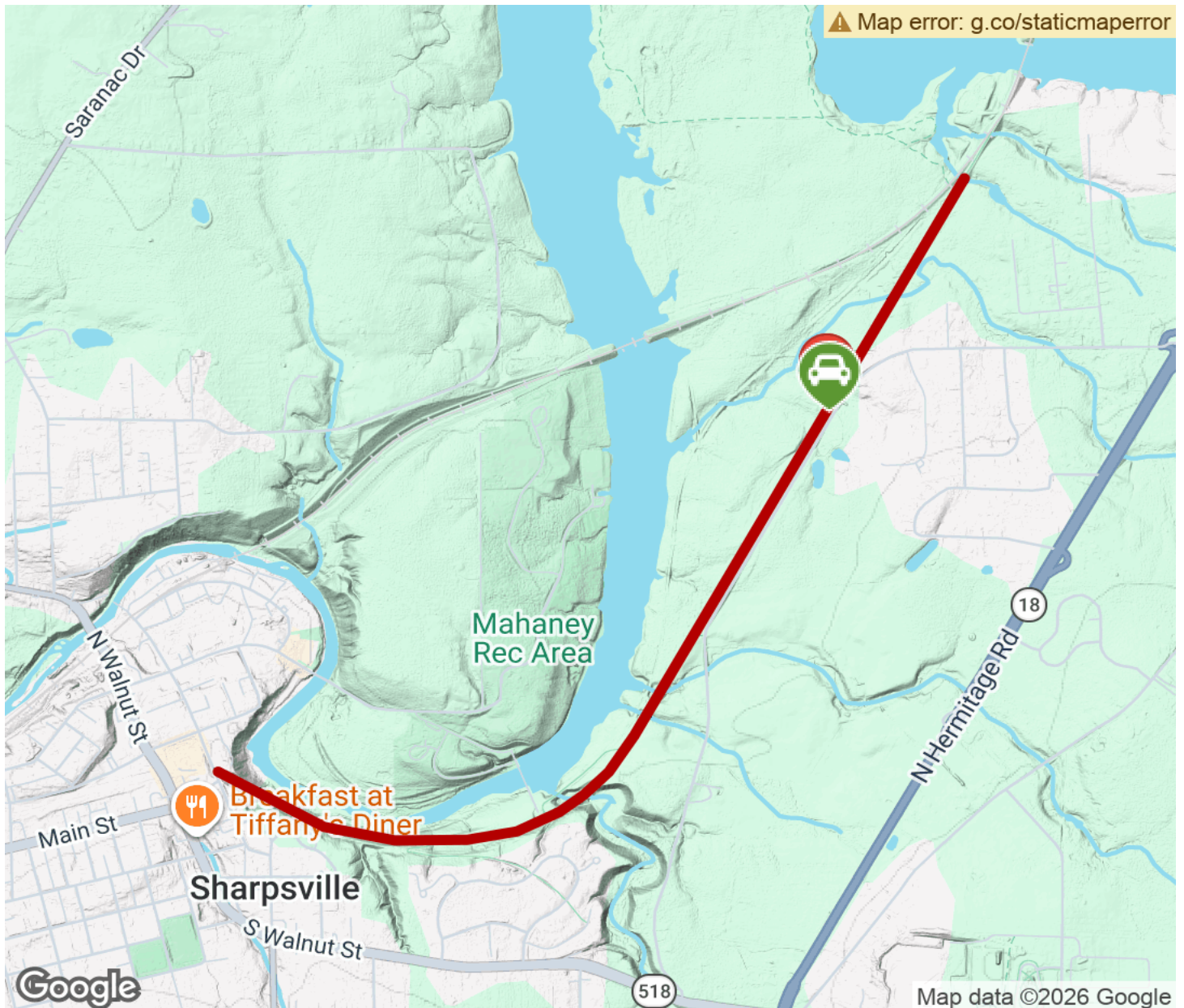
Parking & Trail Access
