Parking for the Bob Lake Trail is available near the trail's southern end and off 48th Avenue just south of Loup Canal.



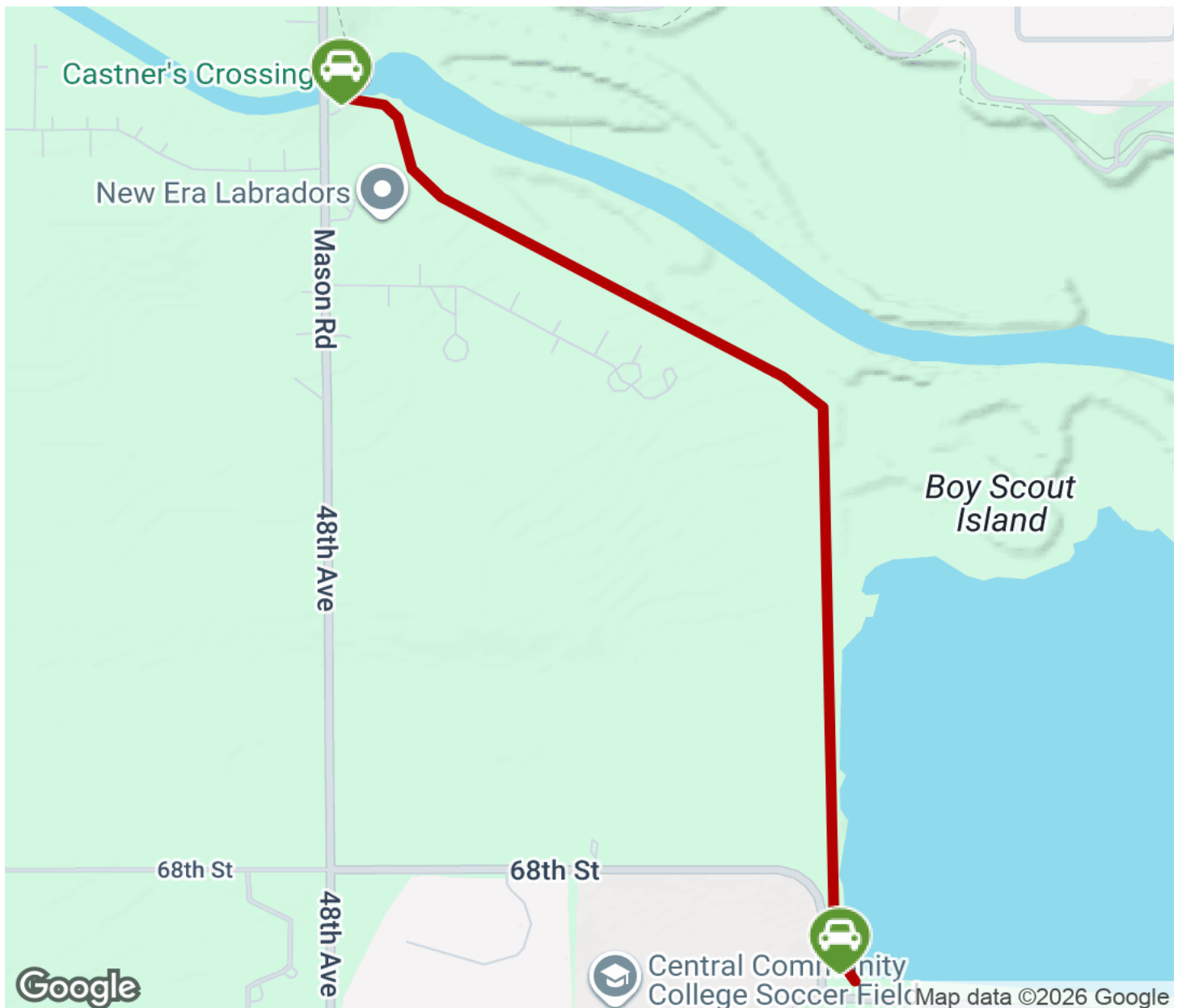
