The South Barre Bike Path is a paved trail approximately 1 mile long, running from Bridge Street in south Barre to Fairview Street



The South Barre Bike Path is a paved trail approximately 1 mile long, running from Bridge Street in south Barre to Fairview Street in Barre City. The path passes the Barre City Elementary and Middle School, which is the location of the only on-trail parking. It is part of a planned trail network called the Central Vermont Path, which will one day connect Barre, East Barre, Upper Westerville, upper Graniteville and Montpelier.

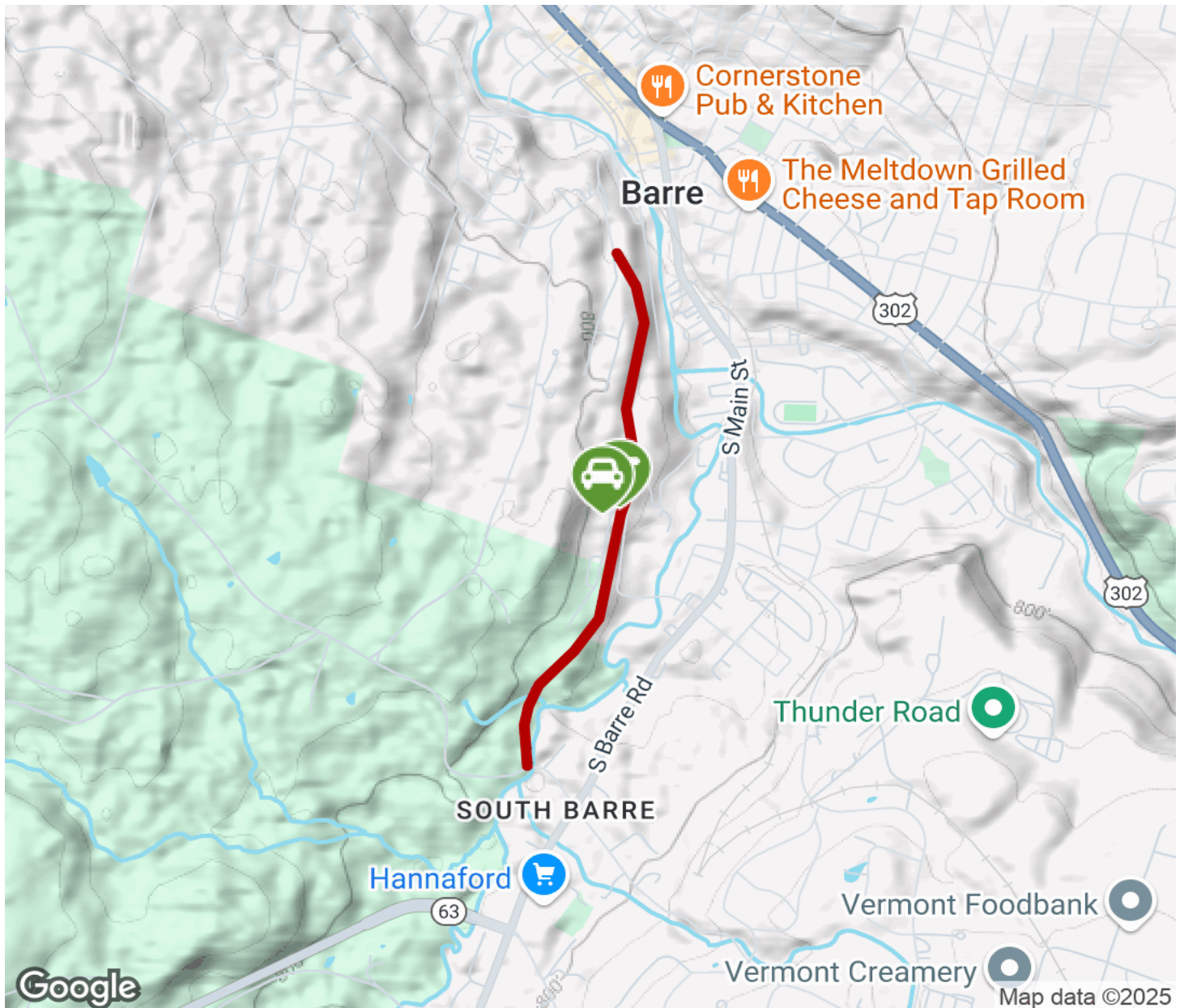
