Aldridge Creek Greenway

Alabama

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The Aldridge Creek Greenway winds along Aldridge Creek for 6.5 miles, providing a pleasant, semirural trail experience in Huntsville. Trail users who keep their noise down and pay attention are likely to spot shorebirds and other wildlife in or around the creek. Multiple sidewalk connections into adjacent neighborhoods make the trail easily accessible for area residents. A community dog park with a trailside gate at Southside Park also offers east access to the trail.

Mostly flat, this greenway makes an ideal trail for a stroll or a casual bike trail. There is minimal shade, however, so be prepared for full sun for most of the trail.

About the Route

The Aldridge Creek Greenway leaves off from its northern endpoint along Four Mile Post Rd. SE, and winds south through there. This northern, disconnected section of trail is also often called the Atwood Linear Park Greenway. The next, southern section of the trail leaves off from just below Valley Hill Country Club. This section runs south to Weatherly Road SE before there is a 0.6-mile gap in the trail, which picks up again at the southern end of Willow Park. Trail users wanting to walk or ride the entire length of the trail should be prepared to use the sidewalk and cross a major intersection at Weatherly Road SE and Bailey Cover Rd. SE in this gap.

2.1 miles south of the Willow Park Trailhead, the trail crosses under Hobbs Rd. SE, which is an area close to the creek and prone to flooding after heavy rains. Just past here, a bridge over Aldridge Creek provides access to McGucken Park, which offers athletic fields and courts, as well as restrooms. This section of the trail runs south until reaching Ditto Landing Rd. and Trailhead, where the trail also passes under a trestle supporting an active rail line.

Connections

At the southern end of the trail, trail users can connect to the [Tennessee River Greenway](#).

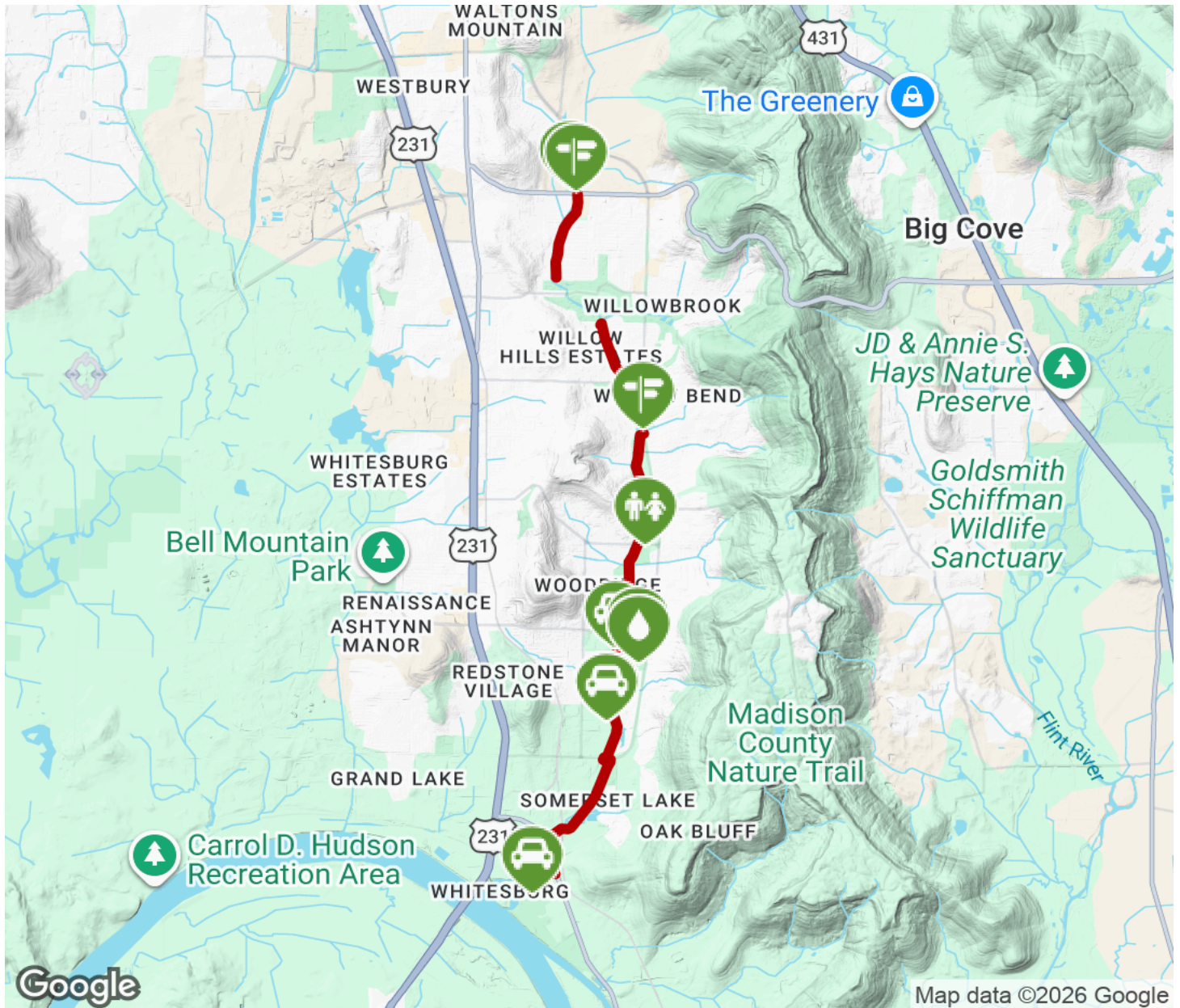
