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Tomahawk Creek Greenway Kansas



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The Tomahawk Creek Greenway follows its namesake waterway through the Kansas City suburbs of Overland Park and Leawood for 12.2 miles.

About the Route

Along its entire route, the greenway provides access for the thousands of nearby residents to a number of commercial centers as well as athletic fields, parks, and two golf courses. Much of the trail's route is heavily wooded, offering a peaceful respite from daily life in the surrounding nature.

Notable parks along the route include Tomahawk Park,



Hawthorne Valley Park, I-Lan Park, Beth Torah Park, and Switzer Park, which is the largest and most notable.

Connections

At the northern end of the trail, the route connects to the <u>Indian Creek Bike/Hike Trail</u>.

At 127th St., the trail intersects with the Nall Avenue Path.

The Tomahawk Creek Greenway connects with the <u>Switzer</u> <u>Road Trail</u>.


