The trail offers views of both the Arkansas River, which is often little more than a trickle, and nearby farming operations.

Parking for the Great Bend Levee Trail is available in a small lot off W. Barton County Road, on the western side of Great Bend.



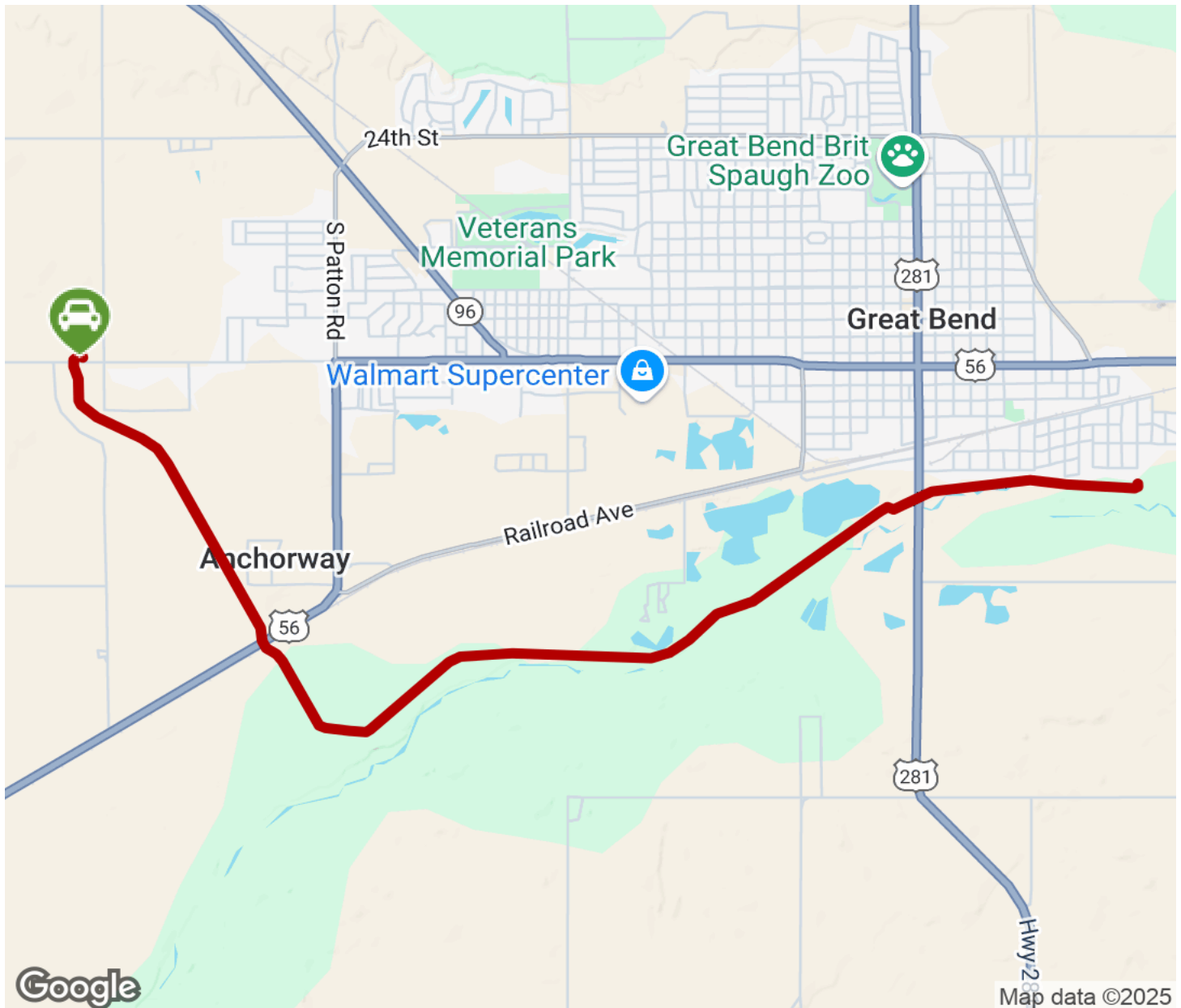
