Most of the Ralston Creek Trail follows its namesake waterway, winding through several parks, neighborhoods and open areas in Arvada. On its western end, the trail becomes gently hilly and passes scenic Tucker Lake and the Arvada Reservoir. A highlight of the route is a trek over the spectacular Gold Strike Park Pedestrian Bridge on the trail's eastern end, which spans 400 feet and is supported by suspended cables.

Just past the bridge, trail users can pick up the [Clear Creek Trail](#) for a longer trek southwest to Golden or east to northern suburbs of Denver. In the west, the unpaved and more rustic [Fairmount Trail](#) heads south from the end of the Ralston Creek Trail to North Table Mountain Park and Golden's Tony Grampas Memorial Sports Complex.

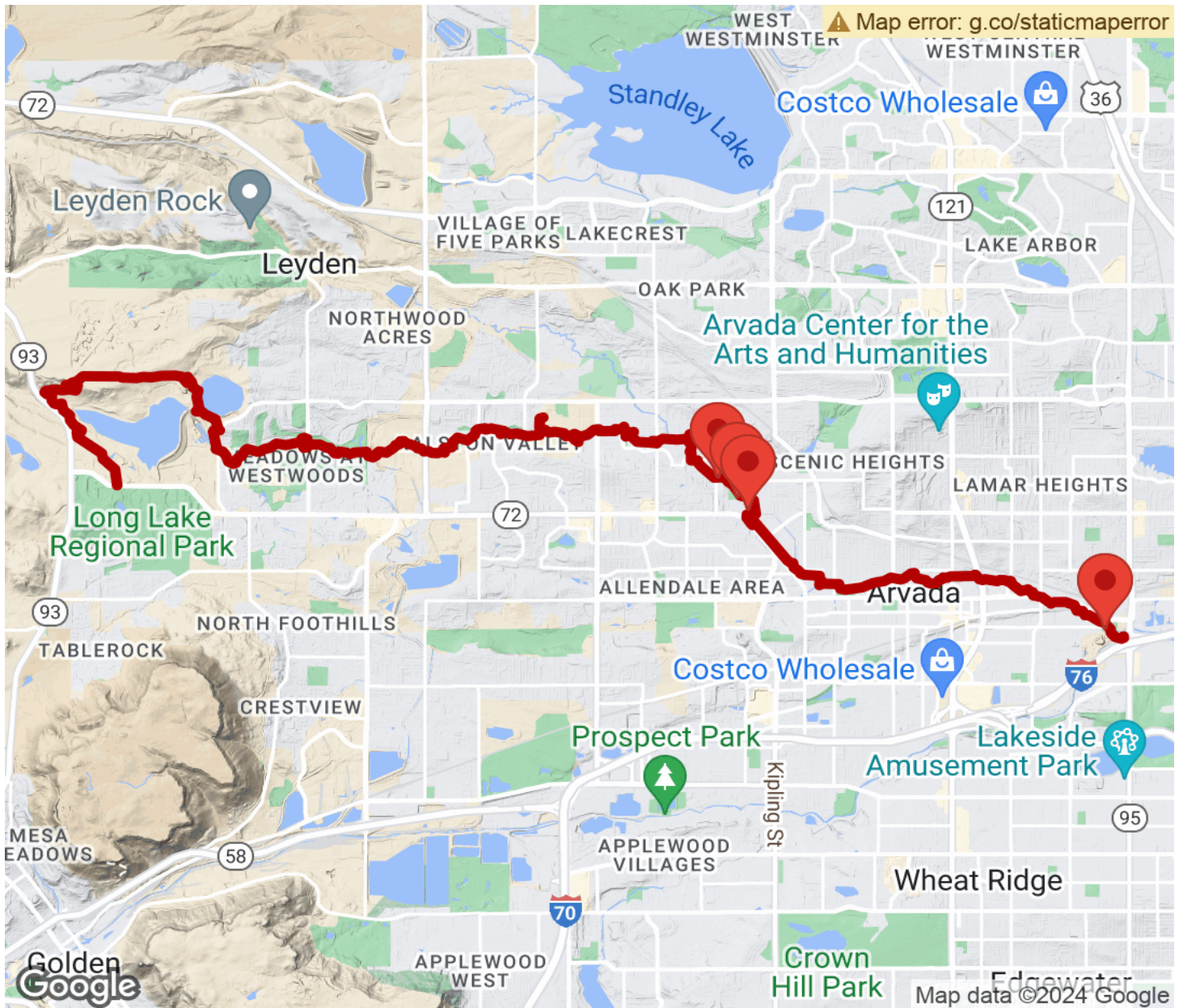
Parking & Trail Access
