The western trailhead is accessible along Larkspur Rd. at Larkspur Park. The eastern end of the trail is located at the end of Hillrise Circle.



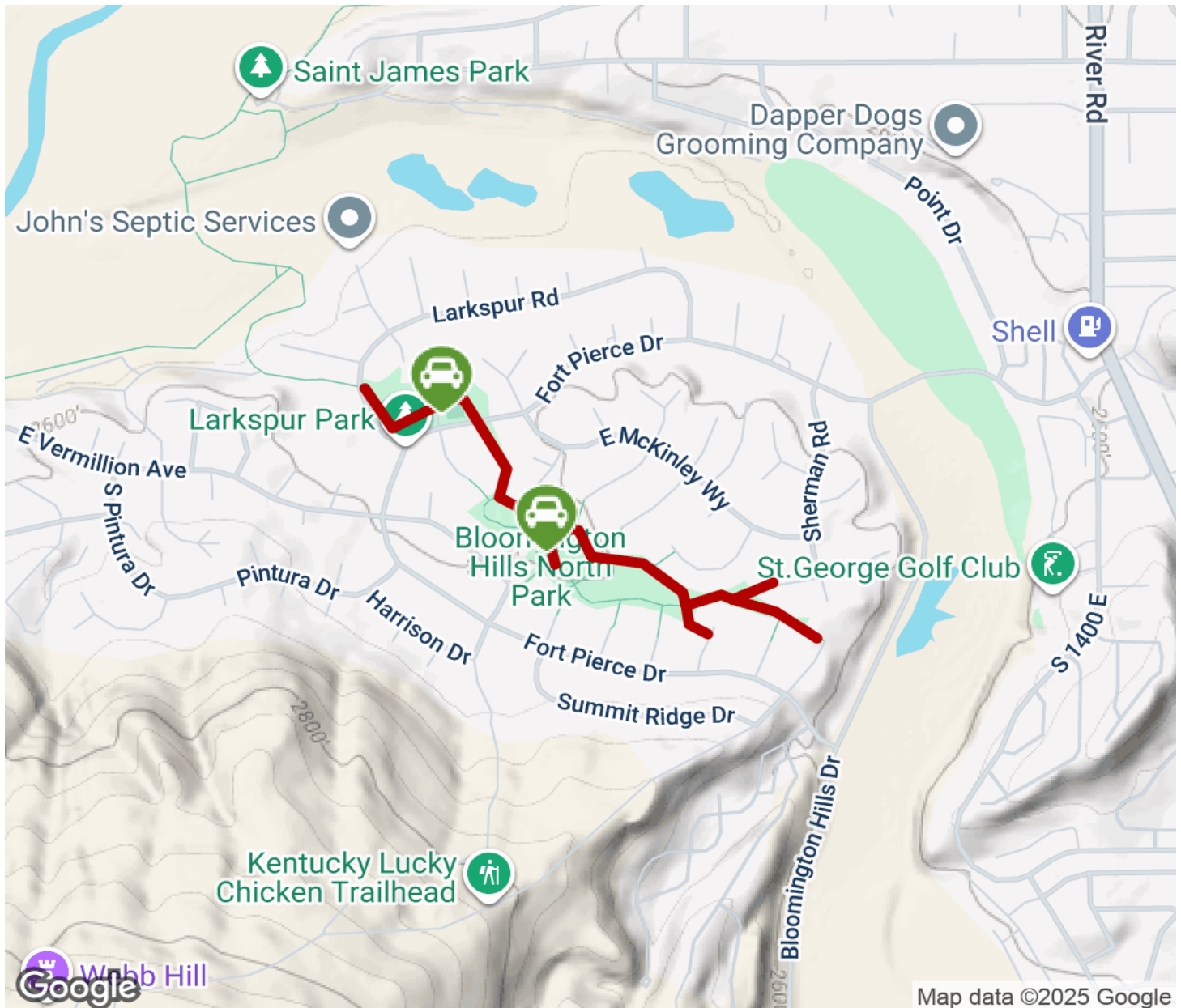
