Trail end points: Just south of Snow Canyon Pkwy., St. George to Snow Canyon State Park

Trail surfaces: Asphalt, Dirt

Trail category: Greenway/Non-RT

Trail activities: Bike, Walking, Wheelchair Accessible

Parking & Trail Access

To reach the upper trailhead from the south, take I-15 to Exit 6 (S. Bluff Street/SR 18) and go for 11.1 miles. Take a left on SR 300/Snow Canyon Drive; the parking lot is just on the left.

To reach the upper trailhead from the north, take I-15 to Exit 8 (St George Boulevard) and go right. In just under 2 miles, turn right onto Bluff St/SR 18. Travel for 9.1 miles then turn left on SR 300/Snow Canyon Drive; the parking lot is just on the left.

To reach the lower trailhead, use the Chuckawalla trailhead on SR 18, 0.3 mile north of Snow Canyon Parkway.



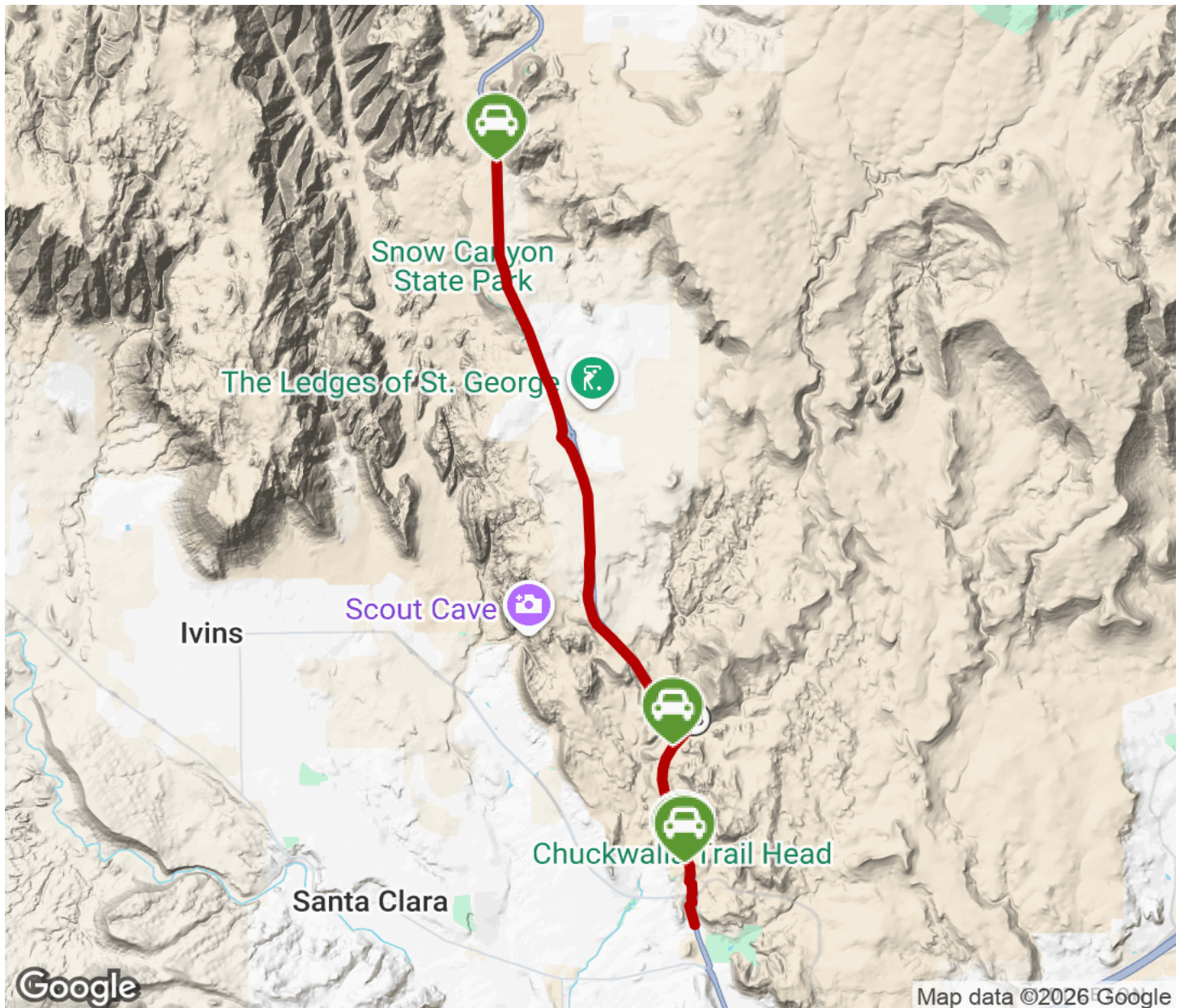
