There are no trailheads for the Dry Lake Trail. The trail can be accessed from the intersection of Kiltie Lane and Woody Mountain Road.



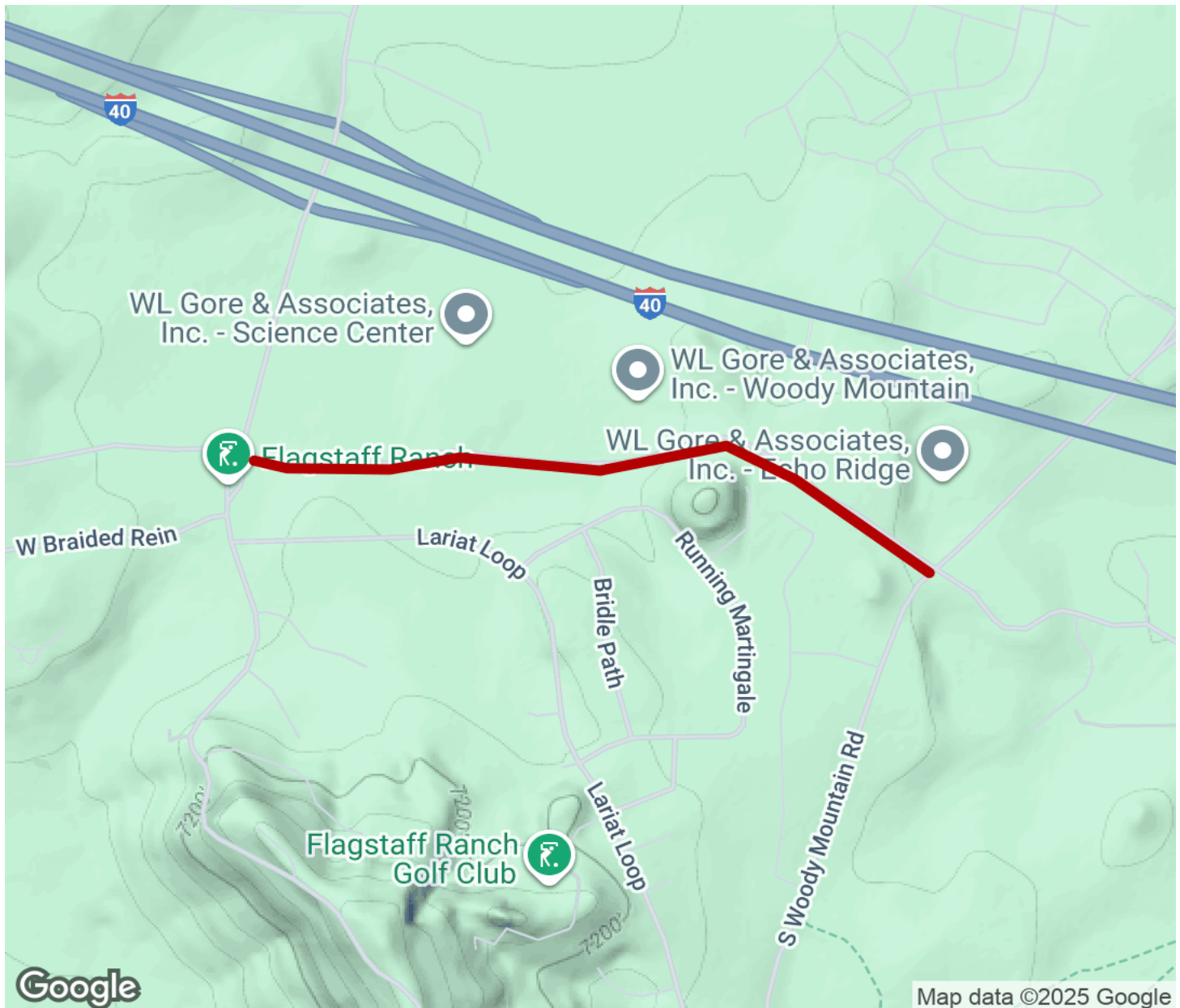
