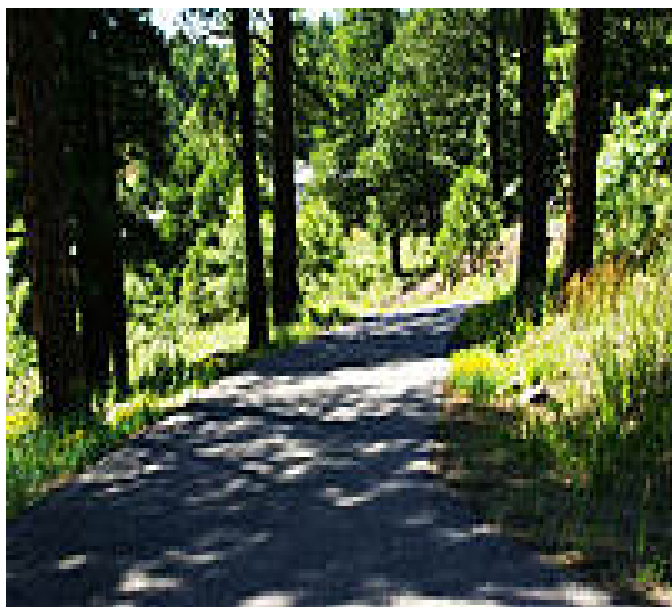

## Southwest Crossing Trail

Arizona

*The Southwest Crossing Trail runs adjacent to Highland Mesa Drive toward I-40 then passes through open space, dropping down*



The Southwest Crossing Trail runs adjacent to Highland Mesa Drive toward I-40 then passes through open space, dropping down to go below I-40. The crossing was first built to move sheep but now funnels pedestrians and cyclists. On the south side of I-40 the trail connects to the University Heights neighborhood.

There are plans to extend the trail east along Forest Meadows Street to Woodlands Village Boulevard.

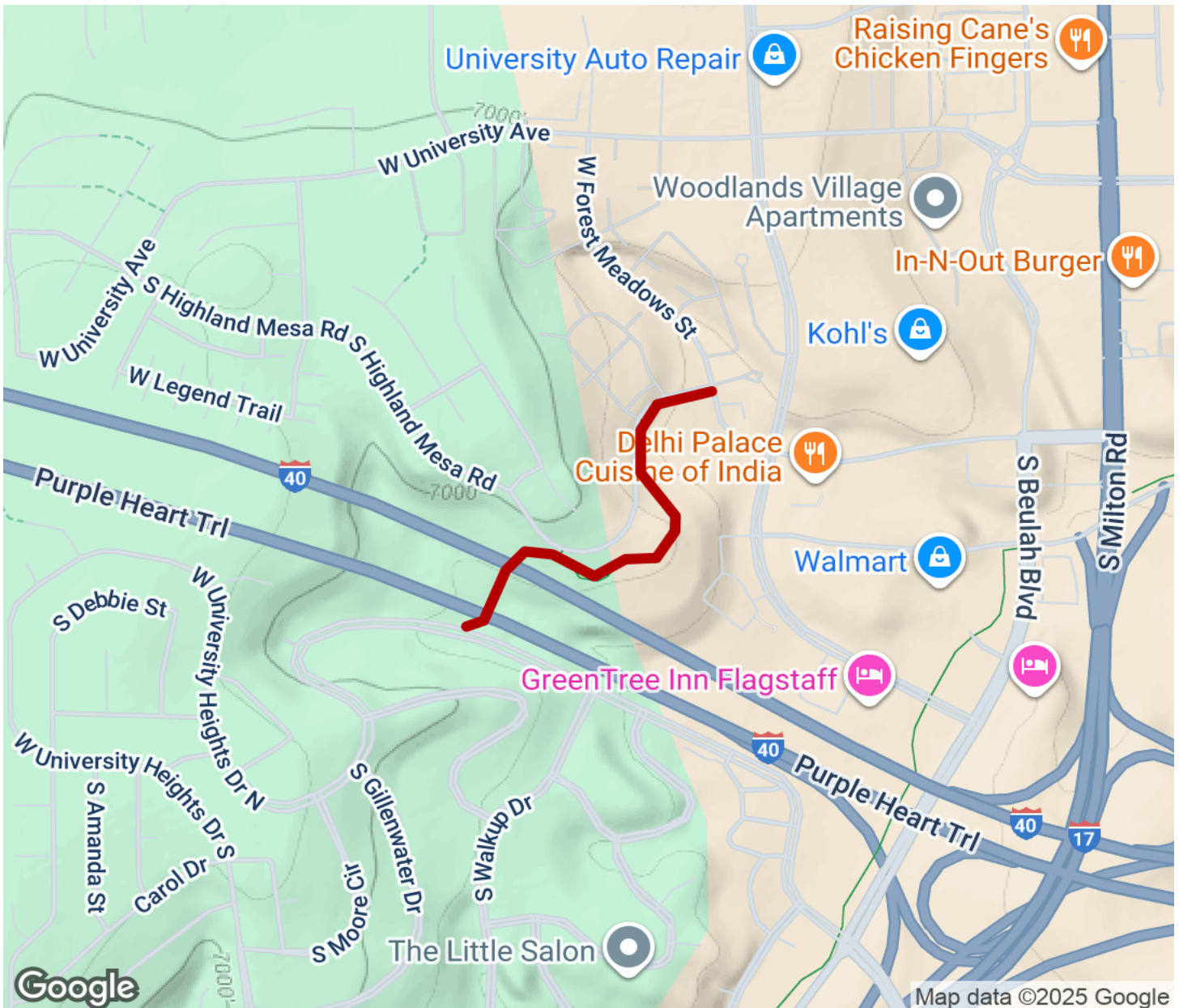
## Parking & Trail Access
