Woodlands Trail Arizona



The Woodlands Trail runs along the east side of Woodlands Village Boulevard from Beulah Boulevard to I-40 (Historic Route 66),



The Woodlands Trail runs along the east side of Woodlands Village Boulevard from Beulah Boulevard to I-40 (Historic Route 66), going steadily up hill from south to north. Use caution when crossing the many streets and driveways this trail intersects. There are plans to extend the trail across I-40/Route 66 to meet the also-planned Santa Fe West Trail. The Woodlands Trail links to the Sinclair Wash Trail at the intersection of Woodlands Village Boulevard and Buelah Boulevard.




Parking & Trail Access
