French Camp Slough Trail California



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The French Camp Slough Trail, also known as the San Joaquin River Trail, parallels both waterways on levees in the southern reaches of Stockton. Near its midpoint, the trail connects to the <u>Pacific Gas and Electric Greenbelt</u>, offering deeper access into the Weston Ranch neighborhood.

There is limited access to the trail at Abruzzi Court, William Moss Boulevard and Carolyn Weston Boulevard. The route is exposed with no shade, so be sure to bring water and wear sunscreen.


Parking & Trail Access
