The trail runs parallel to its namesake road between Providence Road (SR 40) and Battlefield Boulevard. Near the south end you'll find Great Bridge Lock Park; on the north end is Providence Park. The trail passes through several neighborhoods, linking them with shopping plazas and parks.

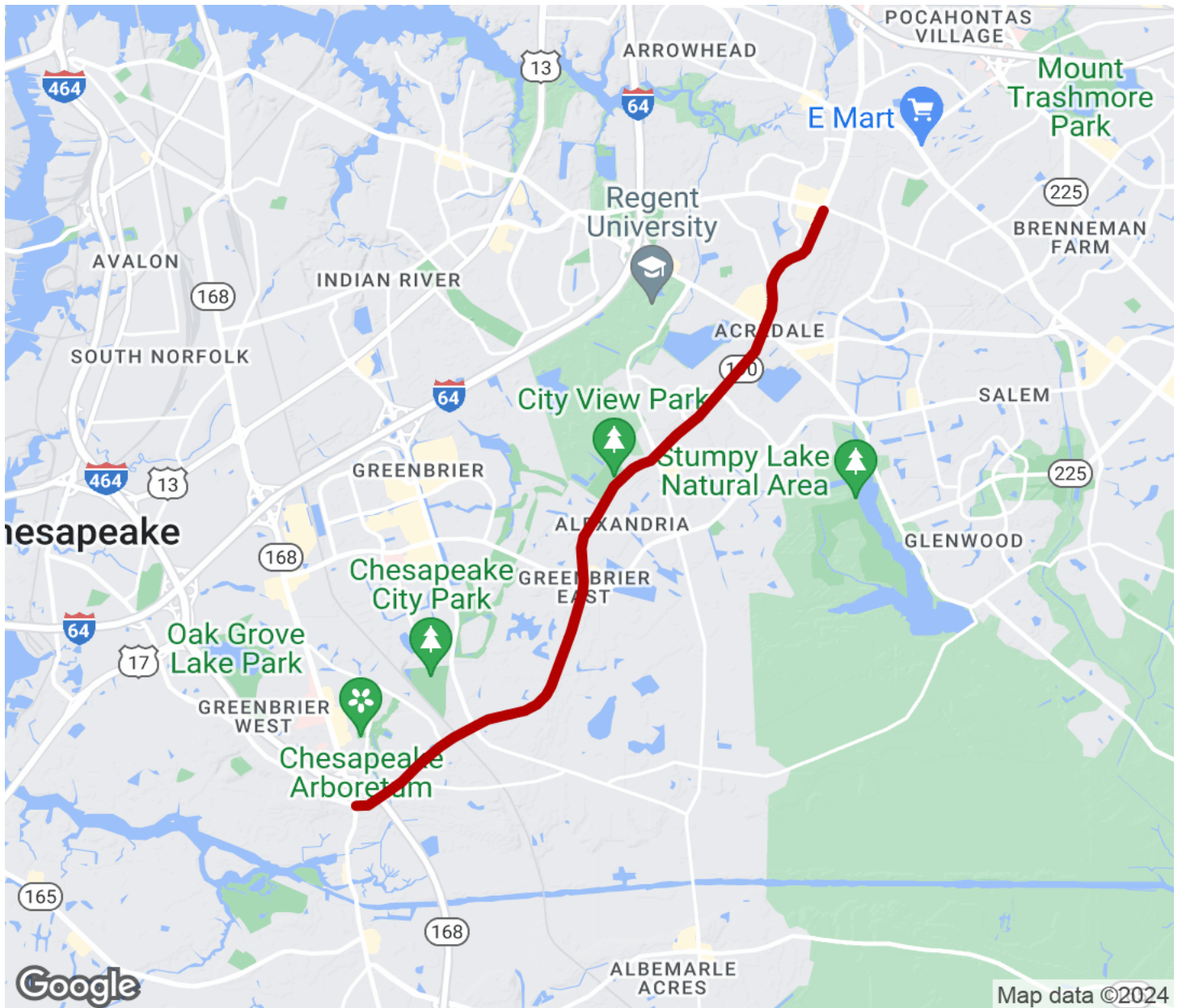
Parking & Trail Access
