The North Redondo Beach Bikeway is a signed bike route that links Torrance to the Los Angeles Metro's Redondo Beach station (Green



The North Redondo Beach Bikeway is a signed bike route that links Torrance to the Los Angeles Metro's Redondo Beach station (Green Line). Portions of the bikeway feature designated bike lanes, while others are shared low-stress streets with simple signage. For less than a mile, a segment of separated, wide, and lit trail runs on an overhead electric utility corridor, offering a nice way to commute through that part of Redondo Beach.

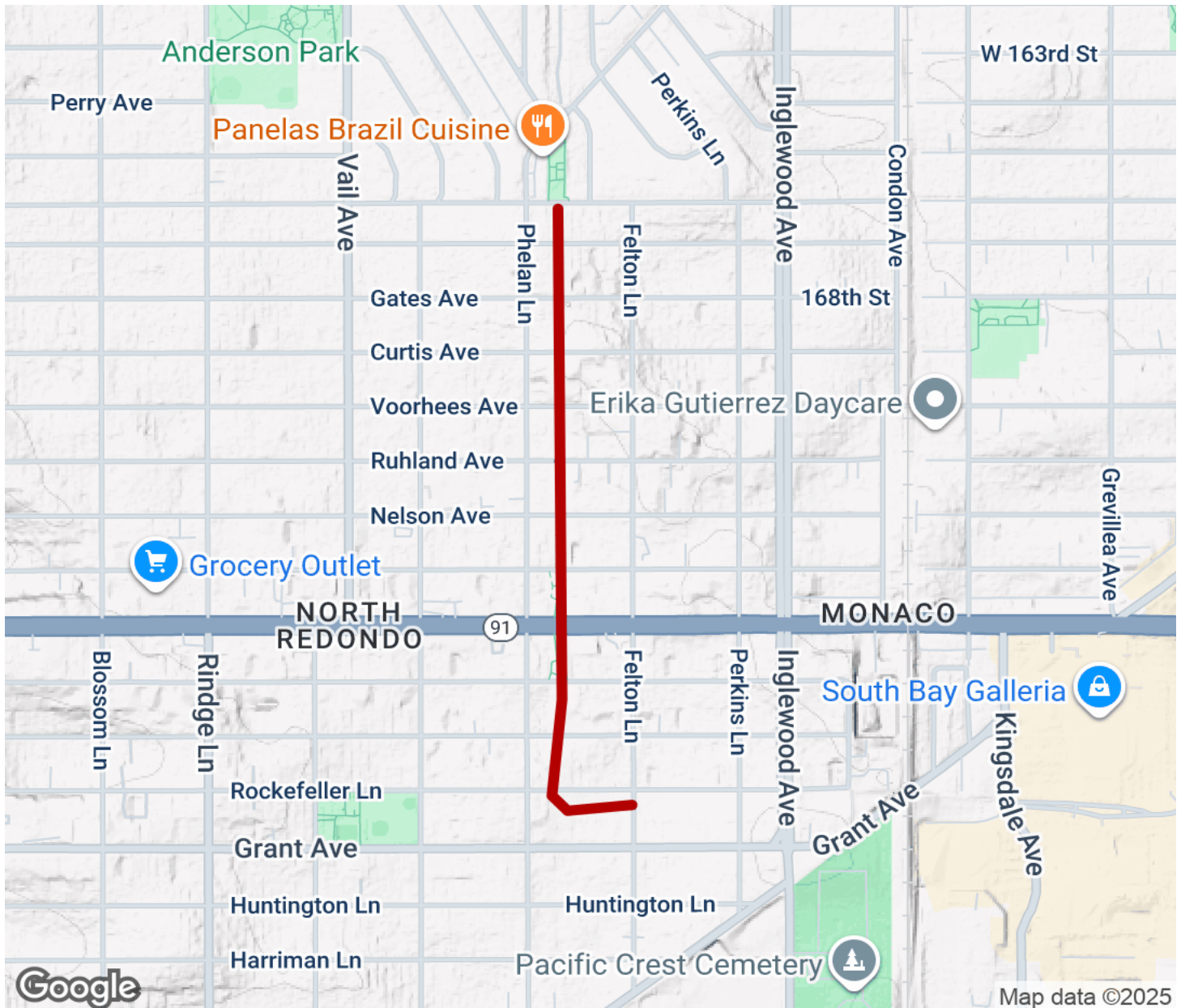
Parking & Trail Access
