Boulder Highway Trail

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The Boulder Highway Trail follows its namesake roadway through southeast Henderson, providing access to numerous residential and commercial areas. There are several major street crossings along the way, at which trail users should be careful.

Near the trail's midpoint, the [Saguaro Trail](#) heads eastward to Roadrunner Park, Saguaro Park and Equestrian Park North. At E. Lake Mead Parkway, pick up the [Lake Mead Parkway Trail](#) instead to extend your journey north or south.

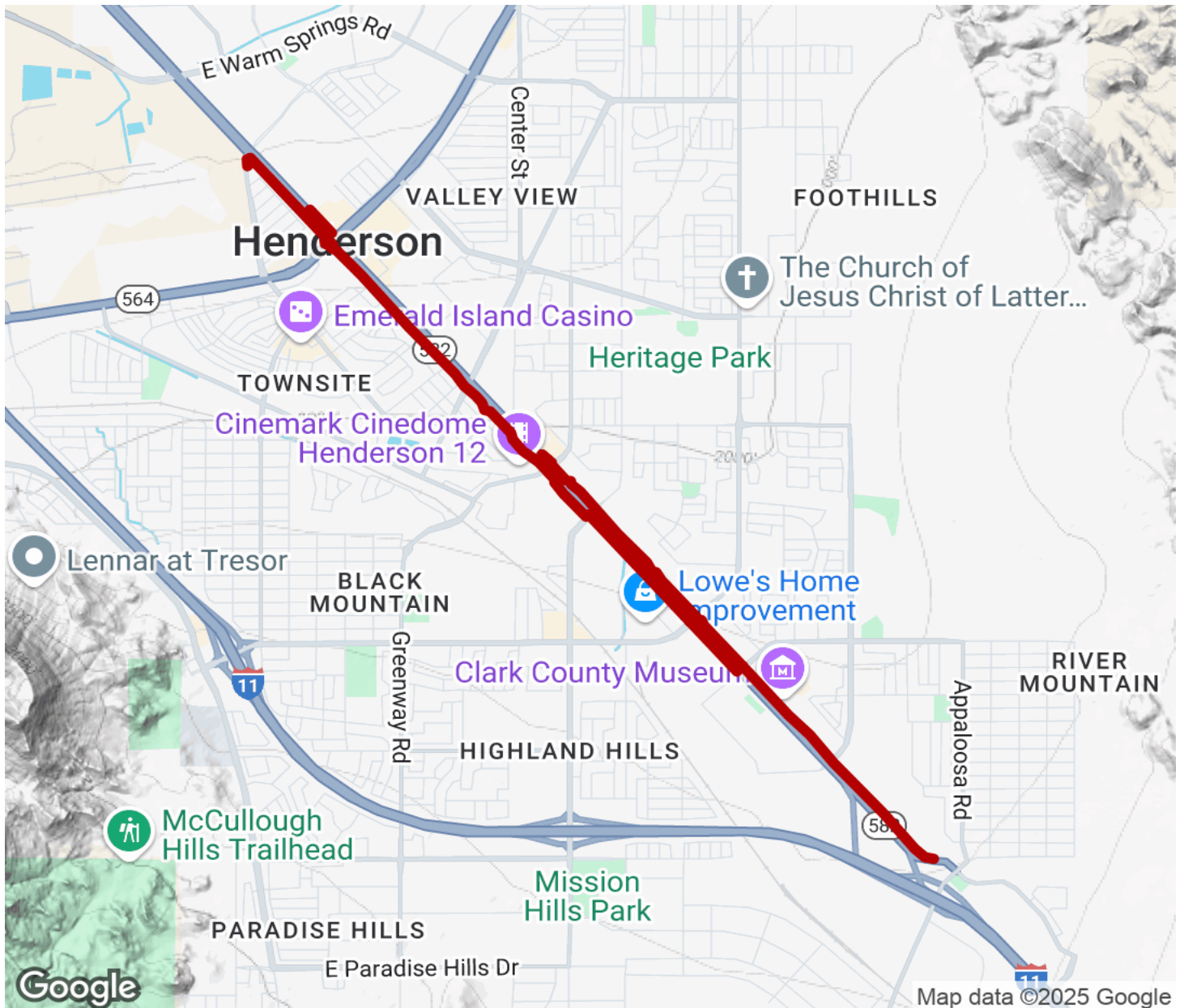
Parking & Trail Access
