The Prickly Pear Trail is a 3.5-mile loop in Delaware Seashore State Park's Fresh Pond area. The trail runs through young forest and



The Prickly Pear Trail is a 3.5-mile loop in Delaware Seashore State Park's Fresh Pond area. The trail runs through young forest and open meadows, with the eastern stretch featuring a crushed stone surface and the western a more challenging sand base. At the trail's northern end, trail users are treated to views of Beach Cove, an inlet of Indian River Bay.

A paved connector trail to the north provides direct access to State Route 1, while to the south the <u>Fred Hudson Road Trail</u> follows the road to its intersection with Cedar Neck Road in Ocean View.

Note that this trail is closed during hunting season. See the DNREC <u>website</u> for hunting season dates and locations, and keep an eye out for signs at the park.
