This suburban route passes by Williamsburg Village, one of the city's most distinctive neighborhoods, and SouthPointe Pavilions, an outdoor mall. Those wishing to continue north through the heart of Lincoln can hop on the popular [Rock Island Trail](#), which runs along a former railroad corridor beginning at the Southpointe Trail's western end.

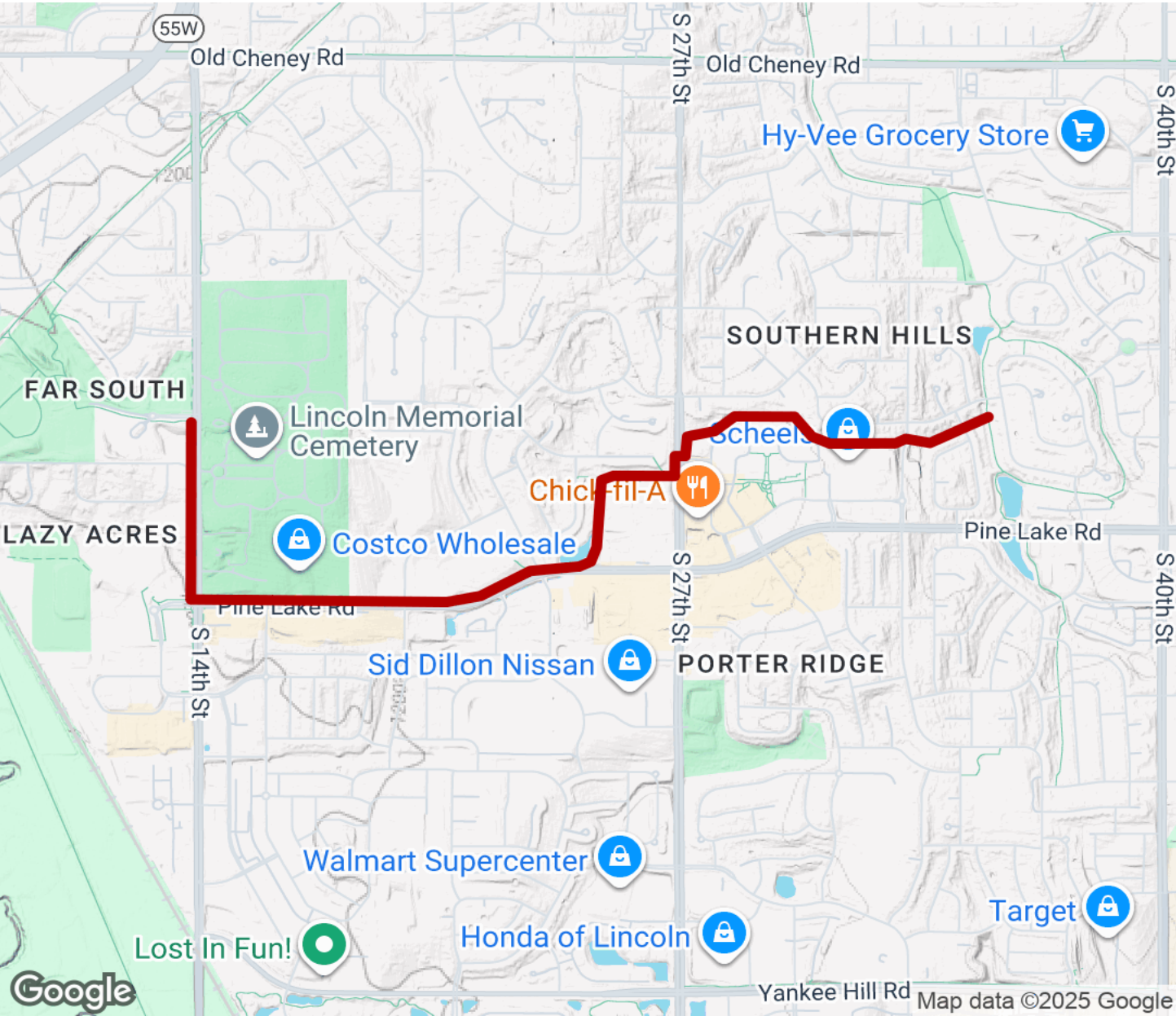
