Parking facilities are located on the east side of Holiday Lane immediately north of Dick Lewis Drive and also within Walker's Creek Park.



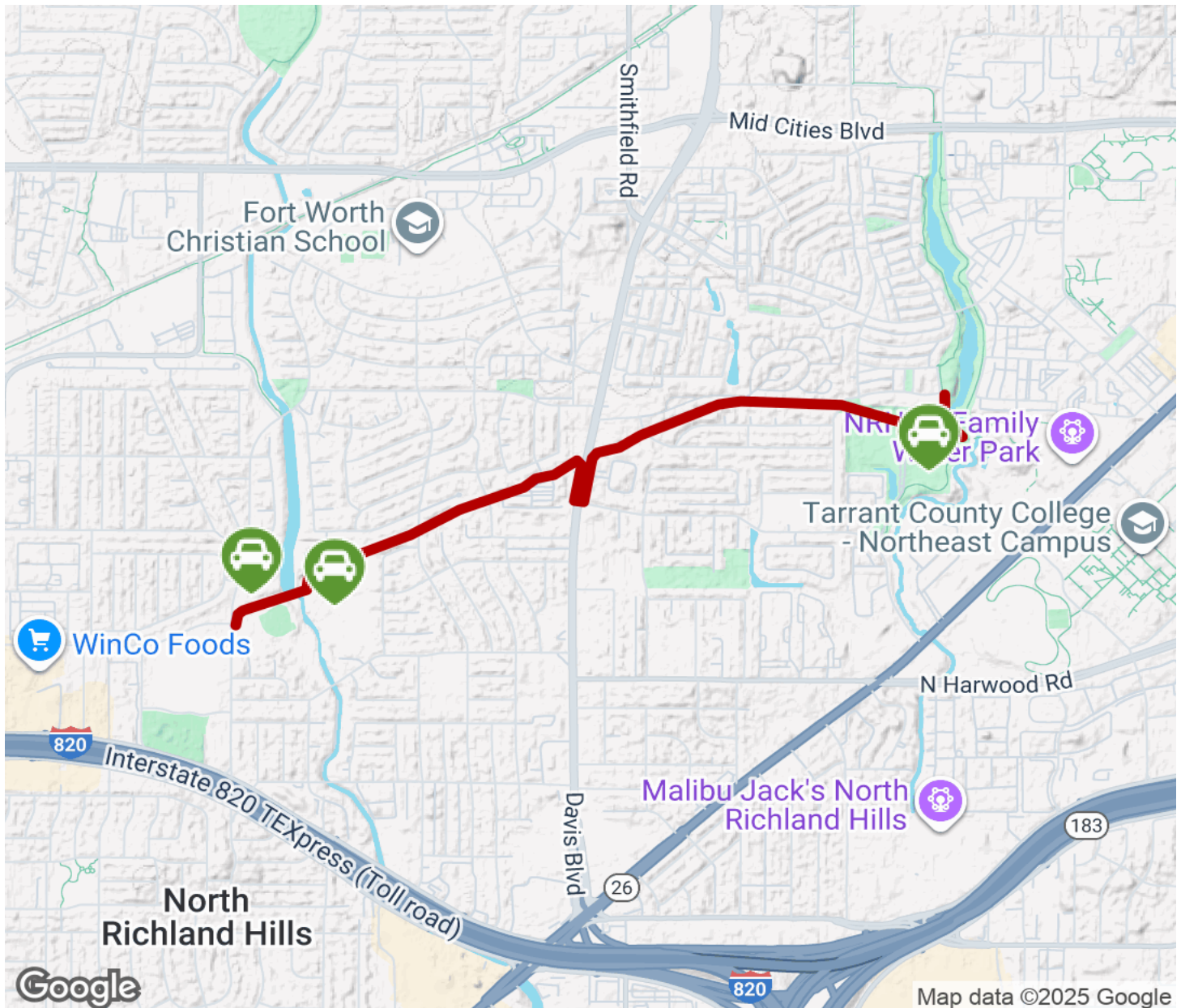
