At the trail's eastern tip is Cravens Park, which offers more walking trails, baseball fields and other recreational amenities.

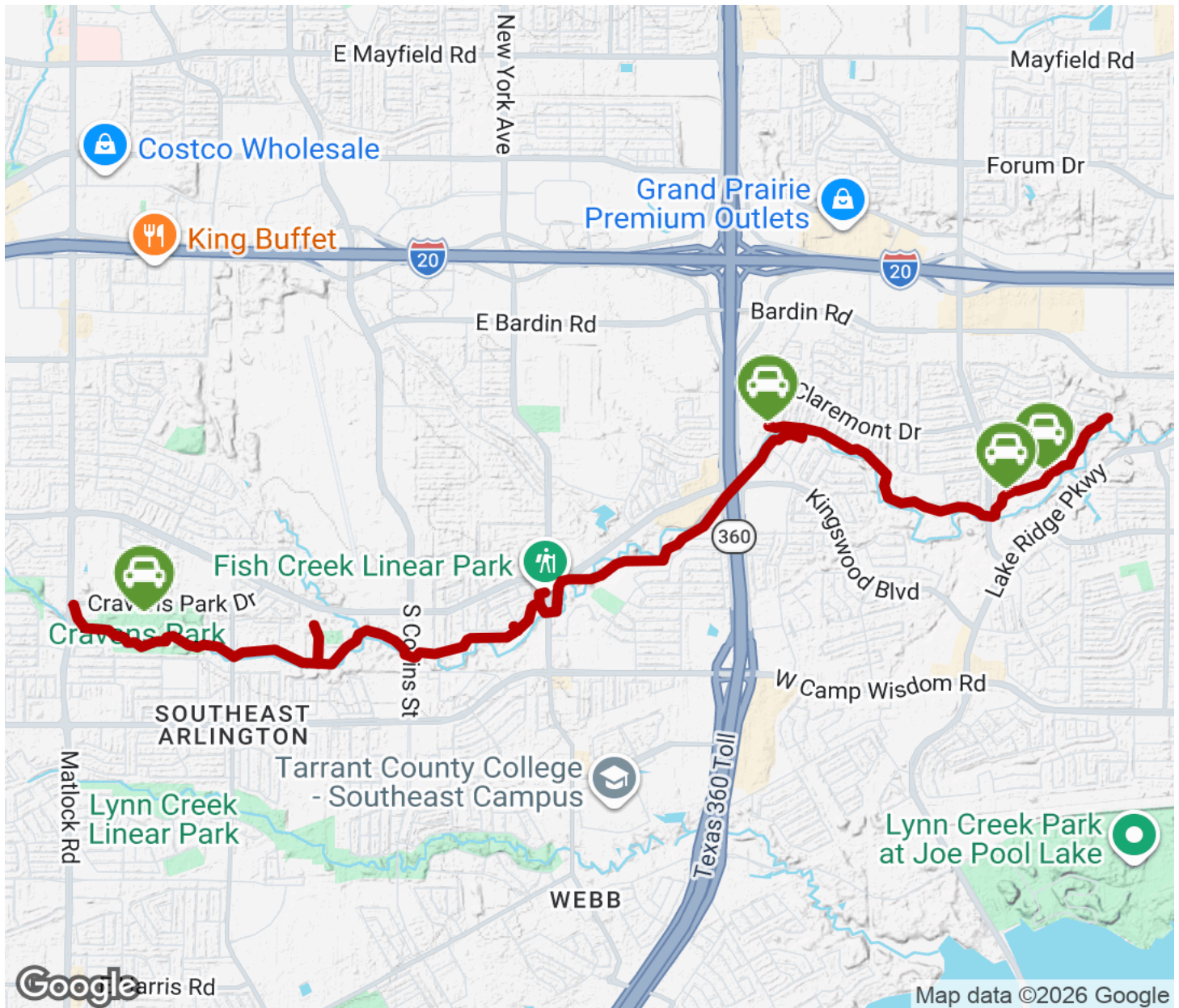
## Parking & Trail Access
