Soon after, the trail connects with the path along [Little Bear Creek](#), if you wish to head north or south. This portion of the trails provides lovely views in a natural, tree-lined setting.

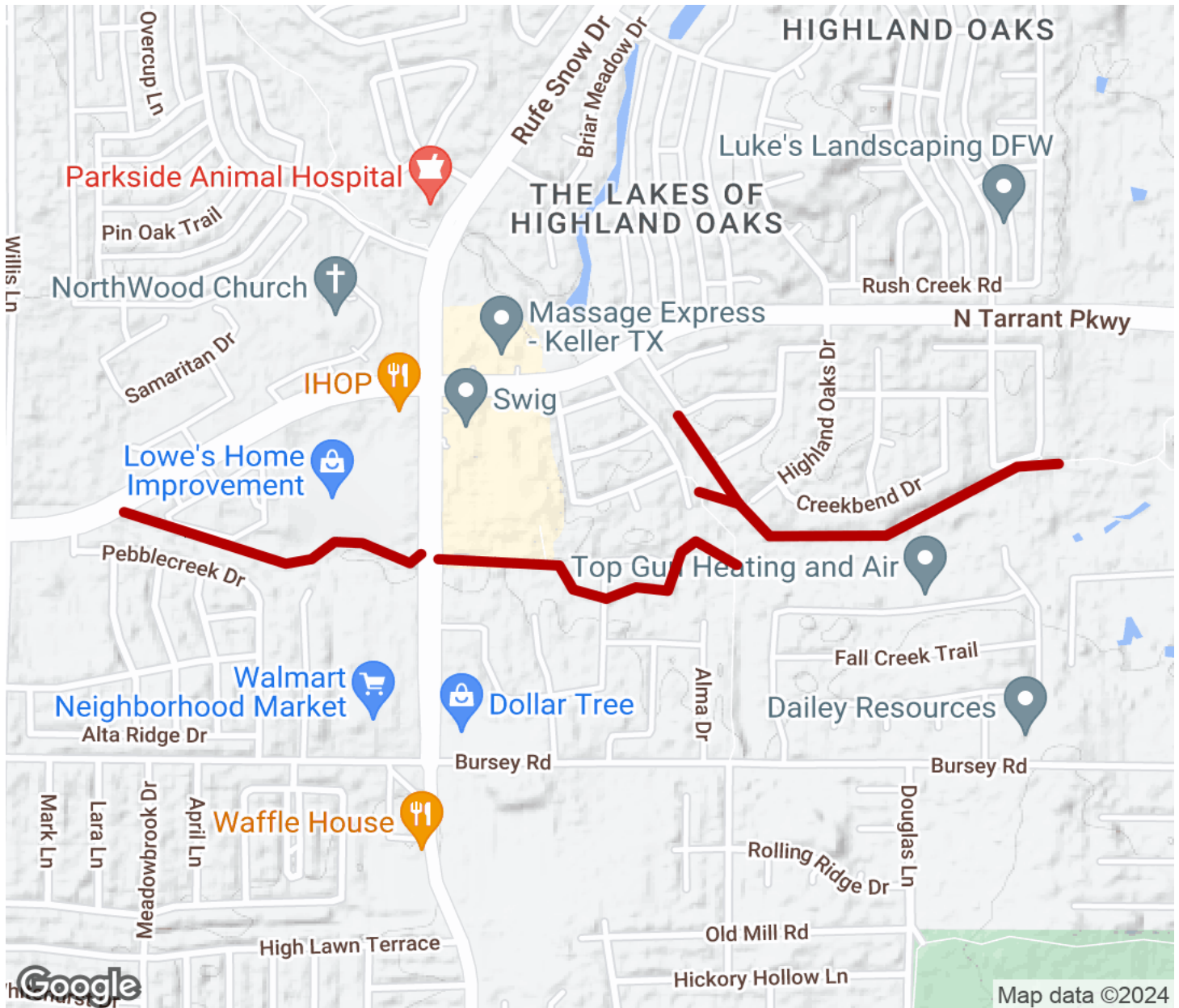
