From Tom Field Road, the trail travels east following a creek through Rawhide Park. At Webb Chapel Road, the trail loops around a lake and continues back to its starting point along the other side of the creek.

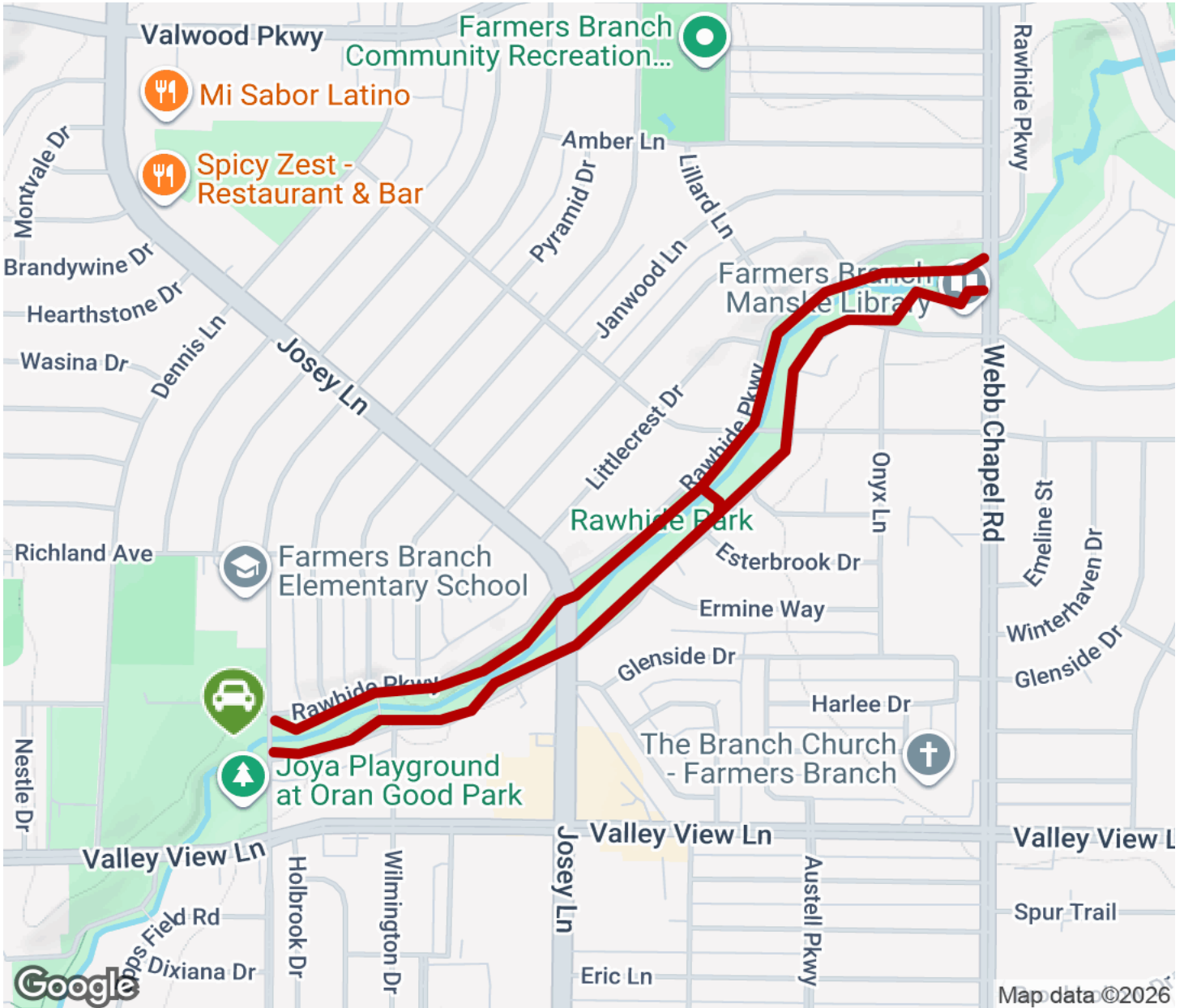
Parking & Trail Access
