The Taychas Trail is located in Frisco, a fast-growing suburb of Dallas named after the St. Louis-San Francisco Railway that was built here in the early 1900s. The trail leaves from Rolater Road in the north and follows West Rowlett Creek south for 1.3 miles. The route runs through a peaceful forested area and passes Limestone Quarry Park, a lovely respite with its prairie grasses, limestone benches and public artwork.
