

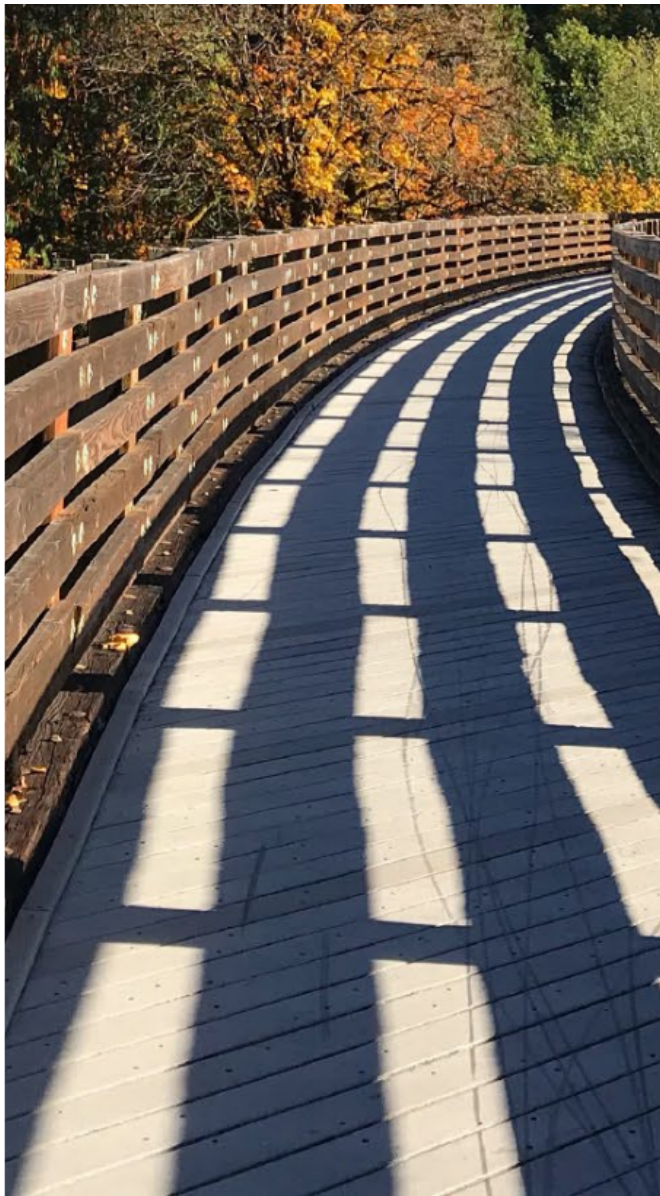

To explore these lakes, you can hop on the [Bert Cooper Trails](#) at the northern trailhead or the [Lake Overholser East Trail](#) at the southern trailhead. The Hefner-Overholser Trail also provides access to the Stinchcomb Wildlife Refuge, a natural treasure of the city.

The scenery on the southern half of the trail is fairly open, becoming densely residential as the trail approaches Lake Hefner. Along the way, the path traces the western border of the Wiley Post Airport, home to the Okie Derby (an airplane race) each August.

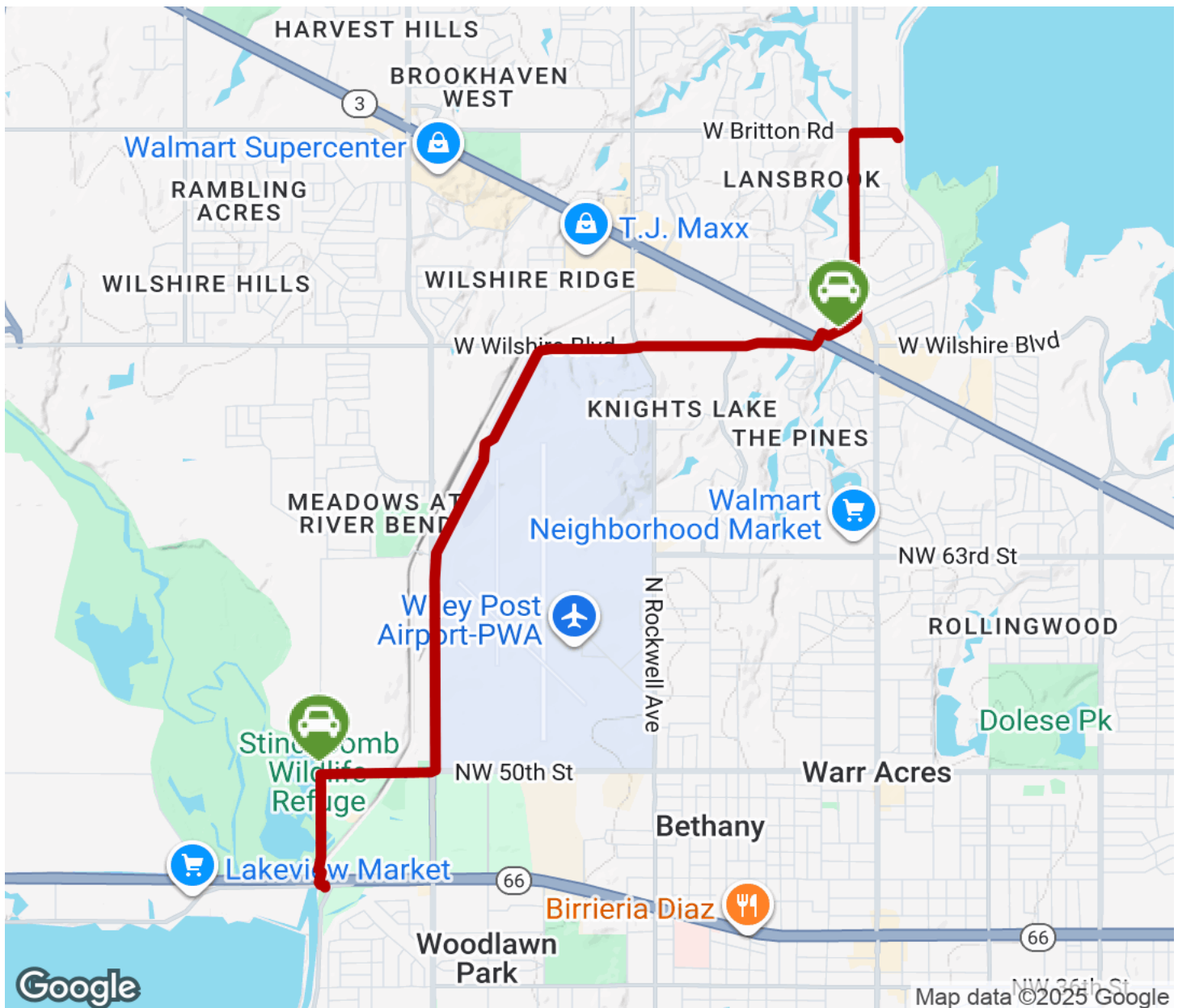
Parking & Trail Access
