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Albuquerque's North Diversion Channel Trail is an important commuter route, traveling north from the University of New Mexico campus to Balloon Fiesta Park, an area used year-round for ballooning, sports, concerts and other recreational activities. The trail offers urban views and connections to the east-west routes of [Paseo del Nordeste Recreation Trail](#) and the [Paseo del Norte Trail](#).

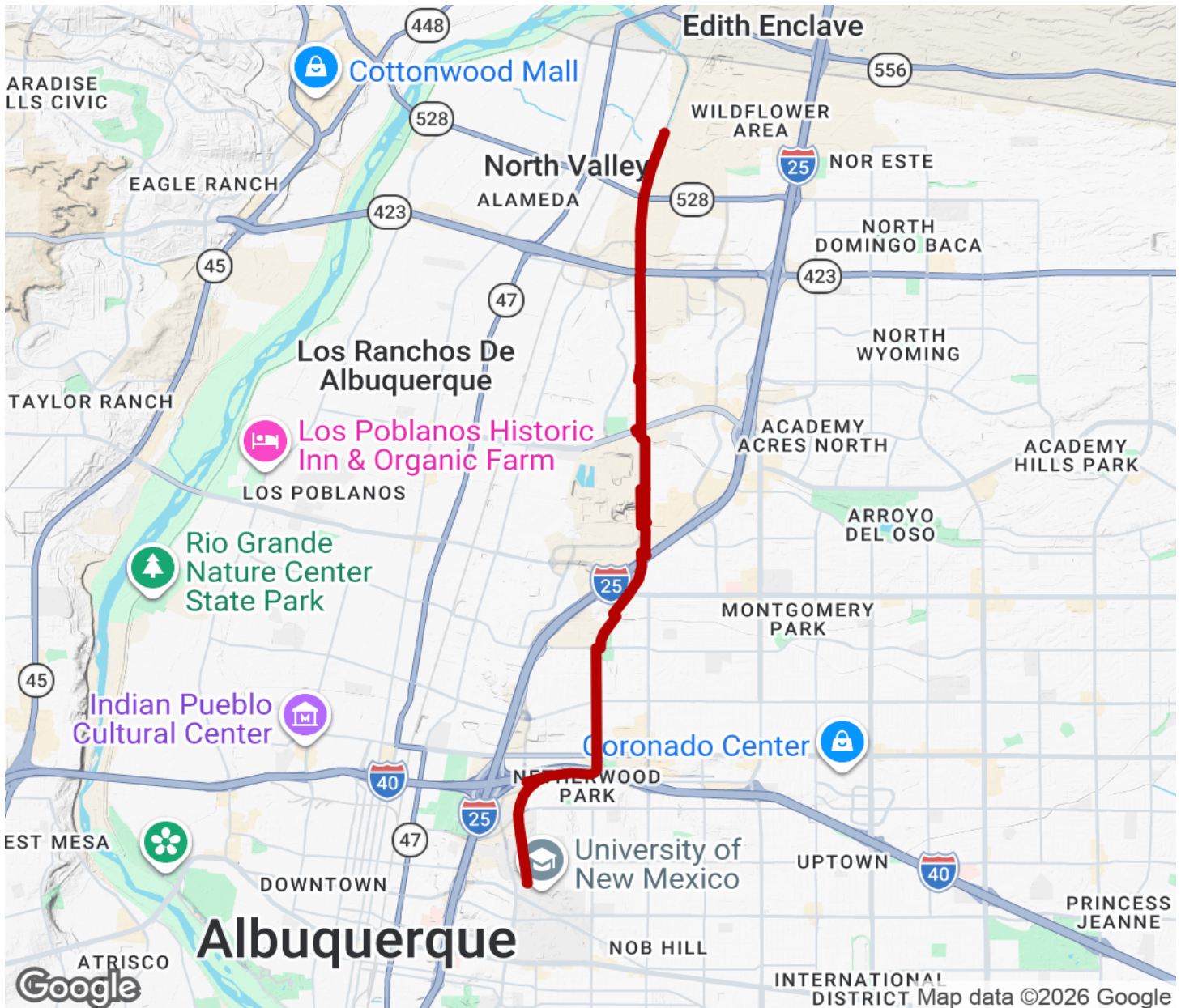
Parking & Trail Access
