Shoal Creek Trail Texas



Although located in the heart of Austin, the Shoal Creek Trail shelters trail-goers from the bustle of the city as it meanders along



At its southern end—on the banks of the Colorado River - trail users can extend their journey another few miles on the Lance Armstrong Bikeway.

Although located in the heart of Austin, the Shoal Creek Trail shelters trail-goers from the bustle of the city as it meanders along the creek under a canopy of old oak trees. Built in the early 1960s, the trail is the city's oldest, and its surface varies from concrete to crushed gravel and compacted dirt.

About the Route

Along the way, the trail passes through Pease Park and Duncan Park, offering natural beauty and abundant recreational opportunities. A highlight of the journey is the passage through a small rocky canyon near the trail's northern end.
