The Eastern Parkway Trail is a 2-mile route along a treelined boulevard in Brooklyn's Crown Heights neighborhood. The path begins at Prospect Park, which houses some of Brooklyn's most popular attractions, including the Brooklyn Museum, Brooklyn Botanic Garden and Prospect Park Zoo. Lincoln Terrace Park, at the trail's eastern end, offers tennis and basketball courts, a baseball diamond, and playgrounds.
