Overview Joe Michaels Mile closely follows the Cross Island Parkway thoroughfare through northeastern Queens for 3.2 miles.



adjacent parks, John Golden Park and Crocheron Park, which offer picturesque scenery, places to picnic, and athletic fields.

The southern end of the trail is located just steps from Alley Pond Park, which encompasses a diverse mix of marsh, forest, and meadow habitats. The park also offers additional trails to explore.

Overview

Joe Michaels Mile closely follows the Cross Island Parkway thoroughfare through northeastern Queens for 3.2 miles.

About the Route

The northernmost point along the trail leaves off from Little Bay Park, which offers lovely views of the Throgs Neck Bridge and the bay.

As the trail heads south alongside the parkway, it skirts Bayside Marina, which has a snack bar and is a pleasant place to rest with scenic views of the water, sailboats, and open sky. As the trail continues south, it passes two

- Bayside Marina, 28-05 Cross Island Pkwy (Queens)

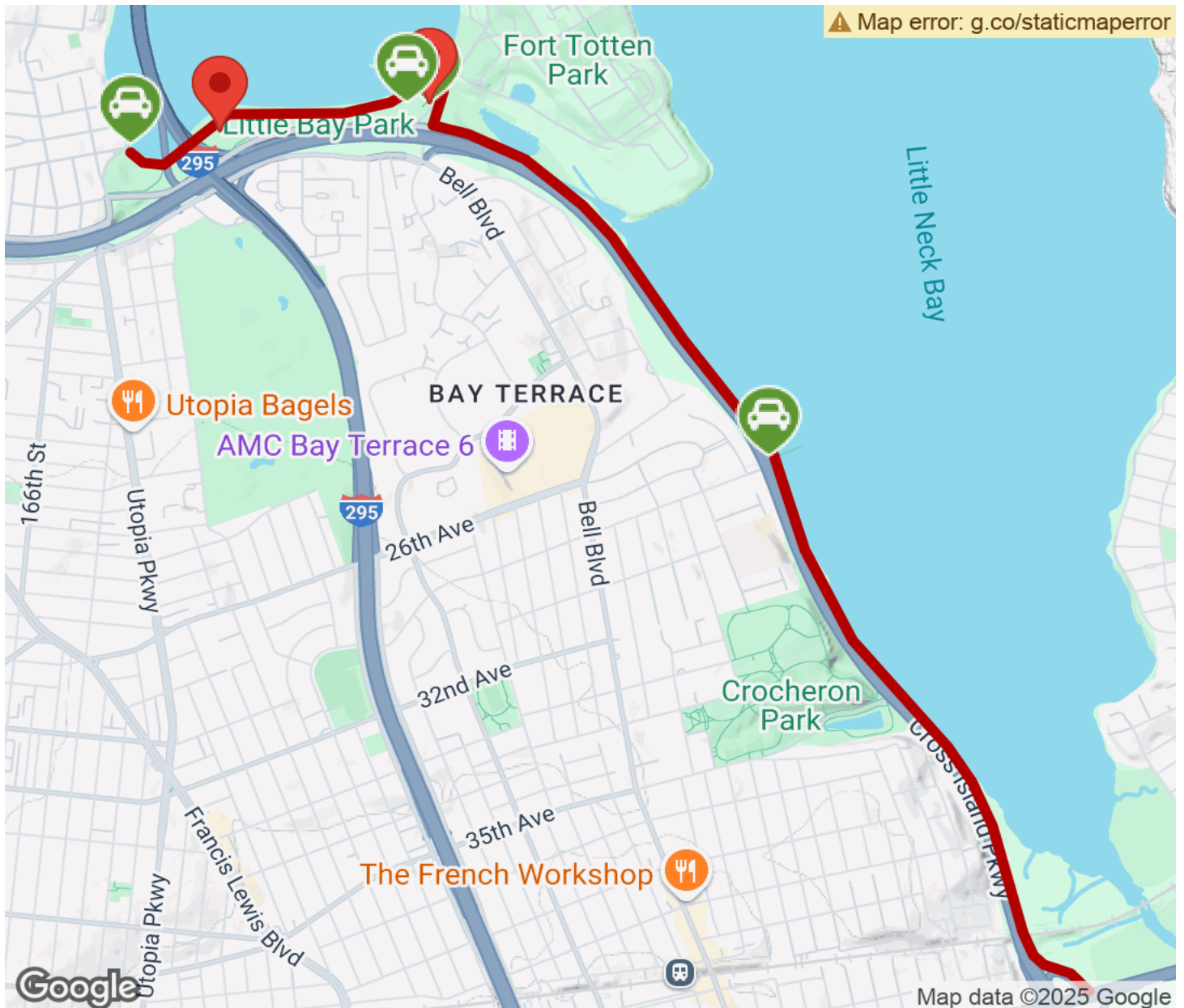
