From the trail's eastern tip, don't miss the opportunity to check out nearby Palmer Park. Access the park from the [Templeton Gap Trail](#) on the other side of N. Union Boulevard and be rewarded with outstanding views of the Seven Castles rock formations. The park also offers botanical gardens, picturesque picnic spots and miles of scenic trails.


