Situated in the northwestern corner of Colorado Springs, the Mesa Valley Trail travels through largely open areas to Sondermann Park. In the park, you will travel through woodlands along Mesa Creek. You may see beavers, deer, coyotes, raccoons and hawks. A highlight of the trail is its great view of Pikes Peak. However, trail-goers should note that the trail's surface is dirt and gravel, making it bestsuited for mountain biking, horseback riding or hiking.
